The Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. through 7:00 p.m. on the day of the election. Absentee ballots will be available up to Election Day. Polling places are: Upton Community Center, Osage Fire Hall and Weston County Events Center. Registration is

permissible on Election Day. ID is required to register & vote.
