During Eastertide the <i>Angelus</i> is replaced with the <i>Regina Caeli</i> (Queen of Heaven).

When You (or someone you love) Visits the Hospital

None of us looks forward to time spent in a hospital bed. Altru Health System seeks to both help with what is wrong physically and also to support patients in other ways. That includes spiritual support.
