DESCRIPTION: The popular Tamerlane was Bear's top of the line target bow. Great looking and performing recurve. I have shot this bow several times, and am able to get really good groups with it. Phenolic and Brazilian Rosewood riser. Bear sight plate and brush rest. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. 2 filled sight screw holes on the face (see pic p. 6). No chips, dings or cracks. Some superficial light stress lines in the riser fade-outs (see pics). A few minor scratches, blemishes and nicks here and there. Typical "yellowing" of the limbs. Decal is in fair condition. Other than the stress marks, the other minor flaw is the repair work and touch up to the edges of a 2" section near the middle of the lower back overlay (see pics on pp 7&8). Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow sold for \$125 in 1966, which translates to \$1,009 in 2021 inflation adjusted dollars.
