Oregon St had a 417-361 yard edge but were -4 in TO's and lost 42-16 at Utah.
Kent St had a 736-450 yard edge but only won 31-24 in OT vs Ohio.
UAB had a 360-209 yard edge but got upset by Rice 28-24. Rice's post-game win expectancy was only 8%.
Auburn had a 438-270 yard edge but lost 21-17 vs LSU. Auburn blew a 17-0 lead and were -4 in TO's. LSU's post-game win expectancy was only 8%.

Pitt scored a TD with :16 to put the game on the "47" total. Georgia Tech pulled the stunning 26-21 upset as the score was only 19-7 with 2 minutes left!
Texas St scored a TD on the final play to put the game over the "51.5" total.

Injuries/Personnel News

-Alabama QB Bryce Young has "a little bit of a shoulder injury," coach Nick Saban said. "It's not a 'long-term' thing, He's day-to-day."
-Arkansas coach Sam Pittman says KJ Jefferson has "mild symptoms" after taking a shot to the head against Alabama. He says KJ is "day to day".
-Colorado coach Karl Dorrell has been fired. OC Mike Sanford Jr will be the interim.
-Colorado St QB Clay Millen is questionable this week.
-East Carolina RB Rahjai Harris will miss the rest of the season with a knee injury.
-Eastern Michigan QB Taylor Powell was dressed for last week's game but DNP. He is questionable this week.
-Fresno State QB Jake Haener, S Evan Williams, LB Raymond Scott and OL Dontae Bull "and a couple more" are out again this week and remain week-to-week, Coach Tedford confirmed Tuesday.
-Louisville head coach Scott Satterfield calls QB Malik Cunningham "day-to-day" and unsure if he will be able to play this week at Virginia.
-Northern Illinois QB Rocky Lombardi is questionable this week.
-Ohio St RB TreVeyon Henderson is expected back this week. WR Jaxon Smith-Njigba remains questionable.
-Oklahoma coach Brent Venables said the Sooners have three quarterbacks getting snaps this week — Davis Beville, General Booty and Nick Evers — with Dillon Gabriel's availability in flux after he suffered a head injury last week.
-Oregon St coach Jonathan Smith said the team will see how quarterback Chance Nolan responds in practice this week before making a decision about who will start.
-Purdue coach Jeff Brohm: "Optimistic" Aidan O'Connell will be ready this week.
-Texas A&M coach Jimbo Fisher on QB Max Johnson: "We'll go day-to-day. He banged his hand. We'll get Haynes King and Conner Weigman ready to play if Max can't go."
-Troy coach Jon Sumrall on Gunnar Watson: Questionable but possible for this week.
-Tulane QB Michael Pratt practiced on Tuesday. Coach Willie Fritz on Pratt: "We feel like Michael's going to have the opportunity to play this week."
-West Virginia RB CJ Donaldson (concussion) is not expected next week.
-Wisconsin head coach Paul Chryst is out. DC Jim Leonhard will be the interim.

Games in Rotation Order

Wednesday, October 5th

UCF 34 Smu 29. This game was delayed twice due to Hurricane Ian. Both teams had a bye this Saturday to allow for the delay. The Mustangs have held up well in back-to-back losses to Maryland and TCU the last couple of weeks. We bet UCF 10 days ago but all the money has come in on SMU here. Lean UCF.

Friday, October 7th

Nebraska 27 RUTGERS 24. Nebraska got their first win under interim Mickey Joseph last week. Meanwhile, Rutgers was predictably handled by Ohio St. We bet Nebraska on the opener at "Pick" thinking the line would move to 3. That's exactly what has happened. Lean OVER at current numbers.

MEMPHIS 31 Houston 28. Houston has been miserable so far this season and last week couldn't even beat a Tulane team playing their 3rd string QB. Meanwhile, Memphis had a misleading 24-3 win over Temple as they trailed 3-0 late in the 3Q. Lean OVER as the two teams were 8-0 to the OVER prior to last week.

NEVADA 26 Colorado St 23. Both teams are off a bye. The Rams are 0-4 ATS failing to cover by nearly 3 TD's per game so far. They are dead-last in the country at -30.2 ppg. Nevada has somehow won two games but the Wolf Pack are No. 124 in ypp margin and No. 121 in ypg margin. We bet OVER on the openers but all the money has been on UNDER so far. We disagree.

SAN JOSE ST 28 UNLV 24. For three straight weeks now we've seen San Jose St take heavy money in the market place. They've won and covered each of the last two weeks easily. However, we think this line is pricey. Both teams have played similar strength of schedules and statistically are close (both +0.8 in ypp margin). Lean UNLV.

Saturday, October 8th

Duke 28 GEORGIA TECH 27. We got our butts kicked fading Duke last week on these pages. We did bet UVA "+3.5" and it closed "+2". However, the Blue Devils were clearly the right side. Duke is +1.4 in ypp margin (No. 29). Meanwhile, Georgia Tech pulled off the shocker upsetting Pittsburgh as 21.5-point underdogs in Brent Key's first game as interim. We think the Yellow Jackets are a little underrated due to playing a tough schedule (Sagarin's 5th toughest). We lean GT and OVER.

MARYLAND 31 Purdue 28. Purdue saw the return of QB Aidan O'Connell and the Boilers upset Minnesota as 9-point underdogs. This is an underrated Purdue team with a pair of close losses that could've went their way (Penn St and Cuse who are a combined 10-0). Meanwhile, Maryland continues to impress. The Terps are +2.0 in ypp margin (No. 16). We bet UNDER 67.5 on Sunday but the value is gone. **Louisville 31 VIRGINIA 23.** Keep an eye on Louisville QB Malik Cunningham's status. This current line seems to indicate he won't be playing. Both teams have been disappointments so far this season. We bet Louisville on the open and it looks like if Cunningham doesn't play, we made a bad bet.

MIAMI, FL 35 North Carolina 30. Really important game for Miami coming off back-to-back losses including the biggest shocker of the season so far (losing to Middle Tennessee as 25.5-point favorites). We think the bye should help first-year coach Cristobal reset. It is concerning that the Canes are -0.4 in ypp margin despite playing the No. 114 ranked schedule (Sagarin). North Carolina got over the loss to ND by crushing VT last week. We haven't bet the game.

Michigan 41 INDIANA 20. We bet OVER 56.5 on the openers. The Hoosiers have been running a ton of tempo as they are No. 3 in the country in plays per game at 80.8. Yes, Michigan games are 4-0-1 to the UNDER but it's by a combined 9 points.

Buffalo 30 BOWLING GREEN 27. Obviously, we thought the wrong team was favored when we bet Buffalo +2 on the openers. The market has agreed with us so far. Despite playing similar schedules, Buffalo is -50 ypg and -3 ppg while BG is -169 ypg and -11 ppg. We also like OVER.

PITTSBURGH 31 Virginia Tech 16. It was another "Nard Dog" special last week as it was the 3rd straight year Pitt head coach Pat Narduzzi has lost outright as a 2-TD or more favorite. We think they bounce back vs what could be the worst VT team in 30 years (went 2-8-1 in 1992)! We lean OVER.

GEORGIA 38 Auburn 10. How does Bryan Harsin still have a job? The 17-point blown lead last week vs LSU was a comical of errors. Now he faces what should be an angry Georgia team off back-to-back lack-luster efforts vs Kent St and Missouri. This is a game we didn't bet.

Clemson 35 BOSTON COLLEGE 14. We bet Clemson -20 on the openers thinking the line would close at least -21. BC comes in off their best performance of the season an upset over Louisville (Eagles first ATS win). Upon further inspection, Clemson is off Wake and NC State with Florida St on deck.

Liberty 38 MASSACHUSETTS 14. We won on these pages last week with Liberty. However, QB Kaidon Salter got banged up again. They could play it safe with him this week vs an over-matched UMass team. We took UMass +26 on the open and so far the market agrees.

Ohio St 43 MICHIGAN ST 18. Colorado and Hawaii are the only two teams we've downgraded more so far this season than Michigan St. Meanwhile, Ohio St (in our best Howard Finkel voice) is the "NEWWWW" No. 1 team in our power ratings. They can name the score. We bet Michigan St +18 in the summer. Safe to say that's one of our worst bets of the season.

KENTUCKY 30 South Carolina 20. Key game for positioning in the SEC East. Kentucky has won and covered 7 of the last 8 in the series. Our power ratings pegged this game right at 10 and Circa opened the game at 10. Pass.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

NC STATE 29 Florida St 26. Both teams come in off 10-point losses. The Noles are No. 12 in the country at +2.2 yards per play while NC State is only +0.9 despite playing a weaker schedule than FSU. That says value on FSU. However, we prefer the OVER and we're surprised the market has moved against us.

Tcu 38 KANSAS 29. Obviously, we came up short on these pages last week fading Kansas. We felt we had the right side as Kansas got out-gained by 100 yards and Iowa St's kicker missed THREE field goals. Kansas has now covered 8 straight games dating back to last year. However, TCU has covered 4 straight to start this season. The Horned Frogs are No. 3 in the country in ypp margin (+3.3). ESPN College Gameday will be making their first appearance here but we think the unbeaten season comes to an end for the Jayhawks.

FLORIDA 34 Missouri 24. Florida is No. 26 in ypp margin (+1.6). How does Missouri pick itself up after blowing a game in OT vs Auburn and then taking No. 1 Georgia to the wire. We understand the early money on Florida. However, we bet OVER on the openers and still lean that way.

2★ USF (plus the points) CINCINNATI 41 Usf 17. This line seems pricey especially when you consider a couple weeks ago USF was +24 at Florida and almost won outright. Kudos to Cincy as they are No. 5 in the country in ypp margin (+2.8). However, USF has played the tougher schedule and has back-door potential.

GEORGIA ST 33 Georgia Southern 31. After an 0-4 start, that upset win over Army could have turned Georgia St's season around. Now they face the high-flying Eagles who should have upset Coastal last week. We know the market loves betting Georgia Southern OVERS and we were with them the first 3-4 weeks but now we think you're paying a premium.

3★ OVER 57 KENT ST 31 Miami, Oh 30. Kent St had a 736-450 yard edge but only won 31-24 in OT vs Ohio last week. They were the first team in FBS HISTORY to have a 240-yard rusher and a 240-yard receiver in the same game. We feel that is giving us a ton of value on the OVER here. Also note Kent St's offense is no longer playing Washington, Oklahoma and Georgia's defenses now. We bet OVER 58.5 on Sunday thinking it had good value and we still love it even though the market has moved against us.

WESTERN MICHIGAN 32 Eastern Michigan 26. Eastern Michigan has pulled 3 straight outright upsets in this series while going on a 5-0-1 ATS run. Western has played the tougher schedule this year and got their QB back last week. Will EMU QB Powell play? We bet Western -4 on the openers.

Appalachian St 37 TEXAS ST 19. Texas St was worse than last week's final scoring a TD on the final play. Meanwhile, App St rebounded albeit it was against an FCS opponent. We don't see much value.

WAKE FOREST 42 Army 27. You might remember last year's wild 70-56 Wake Forest win over Army as 3-point road favorites. It will be interesting to see if either staff changes their gameplan. We bet OVER 63.5 on the openers. As far as the side, will Wake be dialed in after playing an OT game vs Clemson and upsetting Florida St? We lean Army.

James Madison 35 ARKANSAS ST 24. The two teams are a combined 9-0 ATS this season! Arkansas St is 5-0 covering by 11.6 ppg while James Madison is 4-0 covering by 15.5 ppg. JMU is +2.3 in ypp margin (No. 9) while Arkansas St is -1.0 (No. 112). That's probably why we've seen JMU money in the market. What we can't understand is all the UNDER money. JMU ranks No. 15 in plays per game, Arkansas St No. 16.

Kansas St 24 IOWA ST 23. "Farmageddon" Iowa St has won 3 of the last 4 including a 45-0 beat down the last time they hosted. Every single game in the Big 12 this year feels like it will have bowl or conference title implications. After back-to-back losses, Iowa St's season is on the line here. They should have beat Kansas but their kicker missed 3 FG's! To the wire.

BOISE ST 28 Fresno St 19. We bet Fresno +9 on Sunday thinking they could possibly get back QB Jake Haener and others. However, Haener, S Evan Williams, LB Raymond Scott and OL Dontae Bull "and a couple more" are out again this week and remain week-to-week. Coach Tedford confirmed Tuesday. Boise who had a dominant second half vs San Diego St now looks like the right side.

OHIO 36 Akron 24. Both teams come in off close losses. Ohio has won 13 of the last 14 meetings. They'll win another here but can you trust laying double-digits with a Bobcats' defense allowing 42 ppg and 578 ypg? We bet OVER 54.5 on the openers but it has been steamed up.

Air Force 33 UTAH ST 22. Did Utah St finally figure some things out last week? They beat BYU at the line of scrimmage (204-117 rush yard edge) and notched their first cover. They actually started playing better the week prior vs UNLV but were -6 in TO's and were -3 again vs BYU. We bet UNDER on the openers.

Oregon 40 ARIZONA 27. Oregon has rebounded from the blowout loss in the opener to win 4 straight. The offense is averaging 50 ppg and 545.5 ypg in those wins. Meanwhile, Arizona has one of the most improved offenses in the country averaging 15 ppg and 120 ypg more than last season. Somehow we bet UNDER 66.5 on the openers as we had too many "priors" factored in. Safe to say, that wasn't a good bet. However, we made up for it by taking Oregon -10.

USC 37 Washington St 24. We think USC has been over-valued in the market place the last couple of weeks and they've promptly gone 0-2 ATS. With that being said, we thought the 10-point spread on the Circa opener was too tight and the market has agreed. Meanwhile Washington St's defense has been a big surprise allowing just 18 ppg and 96 rush ypg. They'll get their biggest test of the season here. We like UNDER at the current numbers.

2★ Utah 34 UCLA 28. UCLA was very impressive last week. Still, the Bruins have played the No. 132 ranked schedule in the country. Utah has played the No. 45 schedule and are +234 ypg and +28 ppg (both better marks than UCLA). The last 4 times these teams have played Utah has won by 31, 31, 46 and 20. This will be closer but we still like Utah here.

Washington 34 ARIZONA ST 23. Can the Huskies bounce back from their first loss of the season? Arizona St hasn't shown "quit" yet with the interim coach as they covered last week vs USC. This line seems high. Lean ASU.

Oregon St 34 STANFORD 28. There's a chance Oregon St QB Chance Nolan might not play. The Beavers are -8 in TO's the last two weeks so they are better than what those finals say. Meanwhile, Stanford is still on the downward trend. The Cardinal are 0-4 ATS and -0.5 in ypp margin (No. 103). Lean OVER.

Coastal Carolina 36 UL-MONROE 23. Somehow Coastal finds themselves 5-0 on the season as they won another close one last week. ULM has played the much tougher schedule and we bet ULM +15 on the openers.

Ole Miss 40 VANDERBILT 22. Ole Miss escaped with a win last week to move to 5-0. The Rebels are in the Top 20 in the country in ypp, ypg and ppg margins. Vanderbilt is off a bye and is 4-1 to the OVER this year. We bet OVER 58.5 on the opener and the market has agreed.

Tennessee 32 LSU 29. At first glance, we like the spot here for Tennessee coming off a bye, playing an 11am local start vs an LSU team that was extremely fortunate to win last week in Auburn. However, LSU has played the tougher schedule and Tennessee has injuries at WR/DB.

TULANE 29 East Carolina 26. Tulane QB Michael Pratt practiced on Tuesday. Coach Willie Fritz on Pratt: "We feel like Michael's going to have the opportunity to play this week." The line movement agrees with Tulane getting as high as -3.5. Remember the Wave won in Houston last week with a 3rd string QB. This game will go a long way in the AAC bowl pecking order.

OKLAHOMA ST 37 Texas Tech 27. Oklahoma St comes in off the big win at Baylor and are now the Big 12 favorites. However, that game was a bit misleading as the Cowboys were outgained by 79 yards. Meanwhile, Texas Tech outgained Kansas St in a loss. Maybe that's why we've Texas Tech support this week. We lean UNDER.

† Texas 35 Oklahoma 28. @Cotton Bowl in Dallas, TX. This is the first time Texas has been favored in the rivalry since 2009! Don't look now but the Horns are No. 10 in our power ratings. It is deserved considering they are +2.1 in ypp margin despite playing a tough schedule. Meanwhile, OU QB Dillon Gabriel is probably out for this game. It could be a long season in Norman after the Sooners defense has been torched the last two weeks. We lean UNDER at the current numbers.

ALABAMA 37 Texas A&M 14. In the summer, this was seen as one of the biggest games of the year. You had Alabama with revenge for last year's loss. You had the Jimbo Fisher press conference rant on Saban. Now you have an overrated A&M team with two losses and easily could be worse. You also have an Alabama team with a banged up Bryce Young. This 24-point spread indicates Young should play. We bet OVER 47.5 on the open but don't have anything now.

TROY 28 Southern Miss 21. Two teams that we think are "play-on". There's been a sharp betting syndicate that has bet Troy three straight weeks now and they've cashed each time. Meanwhile, So Miss is off a bye and are 4-0 ATS. Lean OVER.

MISSISSIPPI ST 34 Arkansas 25. Arkansas coach Sam Pittman says QB KJ Jefferson has "mild symptoms" after taking a shot to the head against Alabama. He says KJ is "day to day". Early week money says he is questionable at best. Also how much does Arkansas have left in the tank after playing a Top 5 schedule so far. This team could be out of gas. We bet UNDER on the open.

Wisconsin 28 NORTHWESTERN 16. Wisconsin surprisingly fired Paul Chryst on Sunday. We think this is more of an audition for the full-time job than an interim gig for DC Jim Leonhard. We expect at least a one-game bump for the Badgers who have been held back offensively under Chryst.

ILLINOIS 20 Iowa 17. Clearly, Illinois has been one of the biggest surprises in CFB so far as we've upgraded them 9 points in our power ratings. They are No. 20 in ypp margin, No. 8 in ypg margin and No. 15 in ppg margin. They are No. 1 in the country in scoring defense (Iowa is No. 3). Iowa has played the tougher schedule.

Tulsa 27 NAVY 21. We've seen money come in on Tulsa in the last 24 hours as QB Davis Brin should be more healthy than last week. Navy has covered two straight but are still No. 118 in ypp margin. We did take Navy +7 on the opener on pure power ratings with regards to a key number now we lean OVER.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN 35 Ball St 26. Seems like a good spot to play on a 1-4 Central Michigan team that has played a much tougher schedule (No. 16 vs No. 102). Ball St rallied from 17 down last week to get a fortunate win.

Toledo 32 NORTHERN ILLINOIS 27. This is typically a game Toledo loses outright under head coach Jason Candle. You know a week after the Rockets look like the best team in the MAC (beat CMU 38-17). Meanwhile, NIU is desperate at 1-4 and blew a 17-point lead last week. Pass.

UAB 32 Middle Tennessee 24. UAB had a 360-209 yard edge but got upset by Rice 28-24 last week. Rice's post-game win expectancy was only 8%. That usually screams value for this week but Bill Clark is no longer on the sidelines in Birmingham. We prefer the OVER here with MT's high-flying offense.

UTSA 40 Western Kentucky 34. Should be the high scoring game of the week. UTSA games are 5-0 to the OVER by 12.3 ppg. We don't see much value on the side but did bet OVER on the open.

Connecticut 27 FIU 21. Both teams come in off outright upsets as huge underdogs. If they weren't down several starters at the offensive skill positions, we wonder just how improved UConn would be under Jim Mora. We laid 3 on the open.

2★ LOUISIANA TECH 30 Utep 25. We're part of the early week money on Louisiana Tech here. We think it's a good spot with them coming off a bye playing against a UTEP team off a huge upset of Boise St and their first win ever as a program in the Eastern Time Zone at Charlotte last week. Also lean OVER.

Wyoming 21 NEW MEXICO 17. Wyoming has exceeded our expectations so far but were overmatched vs San Jose last week. New Mexico blew a 17-point lead at UNLV. We bet OVER 36.5 on Sunday and still lean that way.

† Notre Dame 28 BYU 27. @Allegiant Stadium in Las Vegas, NV. ND comes in off the bye. The Irish have improved their rush yards per carry each game on both offense and defense this year. It's been a bit of a surprise to see BYU struggle at the line of scrimmage. However, they have the better QB here and we expect to see the BYU of the Baylor game and not the Utah St game here. Anything above 3 is worth a look on BYU.

SAN DIEGO ST 35 Hawaii 15. Both teams like much of the Mountain West conference have fell way short this year. We downgraded both more than a TD. Tough laying points with a San Diego St team averaging 19 ppg. We lean OVER.

Week 6 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past six seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 421-355-12 (54%) clip! So far this season those games are 17-16.** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 6 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **South Florida +27.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

DENVER 24 Indianapolis 20. Neither team has impressed this year as both are 1-3 ATS. Indy had a 5.8-4.7 ypp edge last week but lost to Tennessee thanks to giving up some short field scores. Denver lost at LV as the Raiders ran 74 plays to the Broncos 48. We lean OVER here.

Sunday, October 9th

† **Green Bay 26 N.Y. Giants 17.** @Tottenham Hotspur Stadium in London. Believe it or not, this is the first time a London game has featured both teams with a winning record. Obviously, the Giants are a fraudulent 3-1 team. They are No. 25 in ypp margin despite playing the No. 31 ranked schedule according to Sagarin. The Packers got their scare last week at home vs New England as we cashed going against them. We love them in a teaser here. Keep an eye on Daniel Jones for the Giants who is banged up.

2★ NEW ORLEANS 26 Seattle 19. Raise your hand if you had the Seahawks with the No. 3 offense at 6.3 yards per play. Geno Smith has completed 77.3% of his passes this season. That's the highest completion percentage by any QB through a team's first four games of a season. Obviously, it helps when one of those games is against the Detroit defense as Seattle pulled the upset last week. The problem is the defense ranks No. 32 allowing 6.7 ypp. At 1-3 the Saints need a win. They are No. 4 in the NFL at +1.0 yards per play margin despite a ton of injuries. We like them here even though they are banged up.

JACKSONVILLE 25 Houston 19. Jacksonville blew a 14-0 lead last week but still have impressed so far this season while playing a tough schedule. Last week Trevor Lawrence lost 4 fumbles becoming the first player this century to lose 4 fumbles in a game. Houston is -0.7 in ypp margin (No. 28) but they have been more competitive than expected under Lovie Smith. The Jags haven't laid a full 7-points in 3 years. Lean Houston.

1★ Pittsburgh (plus the points) BUFFALO 29 Pittsburgh 17. The NFL Database we use (KillerSports.com) goes back to 1989. The Steelers have never been this big of an underdog in any game. They are 2-3 SU/ATS as a double-digit favorite since 1989. Kenny Pickett will get his first start against a Buffalo team that ranks No. 1 in ypp margin (+1.8). That doesn't sound like a good recipe for success. Last week, zero of Pickett's 13 pass attempts hit the ground. 10 went to Steelers' receivers, while 3 were intercepted. That's the most pass attempts in a game in NFL history without any hitting the ground. We'll play on the history angle (similar to last week with New England) and take the significant points with a long-term winning head coach.

TAMPA BAY 29 Atlanta 19. Obviously, Tom Brady is dealing with issues both on and off the field. The Bucs have lost 2 straight but are still No. 8 in ypp margin. Last week TB attempted just six rushes against the Chiefs, the fifth time in NFL history a team attempted six or fewer in a game. Meanwhile, Atlanta is arguably the biggest surprise of the season at 2-2 SU and 4-0 ATS. Still, this feels like a "get right" game for Brady and we love Tampa in a teaser down through the key "7 and 3".

MINNESOTA 25 Chicago 18. Chicago is a fraudulent 2-2 team as they rank No. 26 in ypp margin despite playing a soft schedule. They've also benefited from conservative game-plans because of bad weather. Minnesota is 3-1 SU but the Vikings are 1-3 ATS and are also No. 26 in ypp margin. We don't have an opinion here.

Tennessee 23 WASHINGTON 20. We think Washington could be the worst team in football. They are dead last at -1.4 in ypp margin. Last week the Commanders had 135 penalty yards, 2 turnovers and just 2 drives of more than 25 yards. Tennessee is also a very disappointing No. 30 in ypp margin. However, the Titans have won two straight and we'd lean their way here.

Miami 24 N.Y. JETS 20. A lot of disagreement in the market with this game. You have Teddy Bridgewater getting the start for the Dolphins and the market downgraded Miami 3 points from the lock-ahead. Meanwhile, the Jets are somehow 2-2 despite starting Flacco for 3 of their 4 games. Wilson returned last week and they upset the Steelers. We lean Miami who has extra time to get Teddy ready.

L.A. Chargers 24 CLEVELAND 22. The Chargers are 3-1 ATS this season but have yet to put a complete game together. The same could be said for Cleveland who is 2-2. The Browns blew the big lead vs the Jets at home and then were 1 for 4 in the red zone last week in a close loss to the Falcons. With the Chargers a bit banged up we lean Cleveland and the UNDER.

2★ NEW ENGLAND 25 Detroit 20. No matter who starts at QB for the Patriots, we like them here. The Detroit defense is brutal allowing 8.8 yards per play and 10.7 yards per pass to Geno Smith last week. The injuries are mounting on that side of the ball for what already was a questionably talented unit. The Pats have played a Top 5 schedule in terms of strength, but are still a respectable +0.1 in ypp margin.

San Francisco 23 CAROLINA 17. San Francisco is on the short week after the win and cover vs the Rams on MNF. The 49ers are No. 2 in ypp margin (+1.7). Meanwhile, the Panthers are a respectable No. 17 in ypp but they don't win and don't cover under Matt Rhule. They are now on a 1-10 ATS run dating back to last year. We want to back SF here but this price isn't cheap especially with such a low total.

Philadelphia 27 ARIZONA 21. Philly is the lone remaining unbeaten team at 4-0. The Eagles are No. 3 in ypp margin so it hasn't been a fluke. Meanwhile, the Cardinals are 2-2 SU but No. 31 in ypp margin (-1.3). It's the Eagles or nothing for us.

L.A. RAMS 24 Dallas 18. As of press-time it hasn't been determined if Dak will come back for this game. We think it will be next week. The Cowboys are No. 6 in ypp margin while the Rams are No. 29. Still, we like the spot for LA here needing a win at 2-2 while the Cowboys are "fat and happy" at 3-1 and have the huge game vs Philadelphia on deck.

BALTIMORE 26 Cincinnati 21. The Ravens led by 17 points over the Bills on Sunday. In Week 2, the Ravens had a 21-point lead against the Dolphins. They lost both games. They join the 2011 Vikings as the only teams to lose multiple games after leading by 17+ within their first 4 games. What is this spread if they don't blow one of those games and are 3-1? Baltimore -3.5? What is the spread if they don't blow either game and are 4-0? Baltimore -4? We think that gives them value this week.

Monday, October 10th

KANSAS CITY 29 Las Vegas 23. KC comes in off the big win at Tampa. TB won the yards per play 6.4 to 5.4 but KC ran 18 more plays and had a 189-3 rushing yard edge. The Chiefs are No. 4 in ypp margin. Meanwhile, the Raiders got their first win of the season as we cashed with them. They continue to be better than their record indicates and we lean with them here.
