## September 18 Program Meeting: John Mariner

John taught art in the Pinellas (FL) County School system for 28 years. During this time he also worked as a freelance designer with local and national clients. He expanded into web design and print production in his business, Graphic Artworks. In 2009 he relocated to Rochester, NY, where he continued his design work. His work borrows strongly from traditional graphic design, pastiche, and other 20th Century artistic sensibilities. He has always been interested in numbers, letters, and symbols, and uses these elements alongside popular imagery. Some have political and social leanings, though many are truly just representative of his experiences. John is a Photoshop expert and will share how he achieves his multi faceted designs. 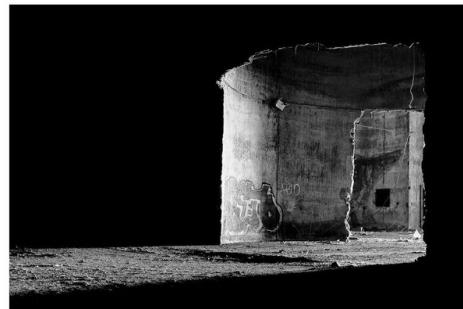
