

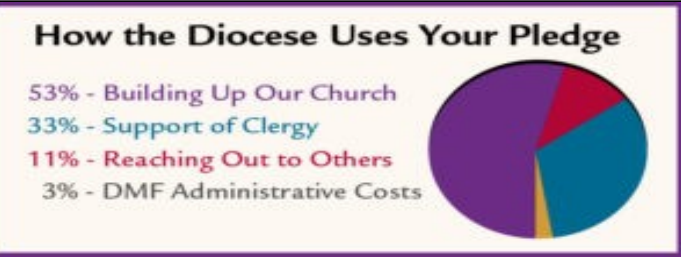

MASS READING RELFECTION

Oct 20, 2019

1st Reading Ex 17:8-13  
[ God Our Warrior]  
On their way to the to the promised land, the Jews pass through territory controlled by another nomadic tribe, Amalex. A tribal war breaks out. Moses picks out a high spot and like the other army commanders of his day holds the staff in his hand. From there he guides the battle. But note that Moses’ staff is called “the staff of God.” In verse 16 (see your Bible), the victory is expressly attributed to God. What did the sacred writer want to ring out by relating this ancient tradition? His lesson is: God fought on our fathers’ side in the past, and he will help us now.  
Why do we read this episode about two warring bedouin tribe in a desert some 3,200 years ago? We do not read it just for information. As believers, we pray and meditate on the point that God wants to bring out through this narrative. It could be: “In the battle of life, I am with you!” With this in mind, we make the words of the Responsorial Psalm our prayer to God.  
2nd Reading 2 Tm 3:14-4:2  
[ Inspiration of Scripture]  
Paul insists that preachers should know the Bible and use it as the source of the wisdom they preach. With Scripture the man of God (priest-preacher) is well-equipped for his job. This implies that we should listen with faith when the Bible is explained in church. But why did Paul not recommend Bible reading by all? Simply because Bibles were not printed in his day and the vast majority of the faithful were illiterates. In our literate age with Bibles available, we should read prayerfully for ourselves (Vatican II: Constitution on Divine Revelation, 22).  
Like the “Bible Pauperum” (Bible stories, painted on the walls medieval cathedrals for the illiterate poor), paraphrased and pictorial Bibles are all right for children and people with a low reading ability. Literate Christians read God’s word in a translation as close as possible to original, try to understand it with the help of introductions and footnotes, and apply it as God’s word to their own life situation, as we do with today’s Bible readings.

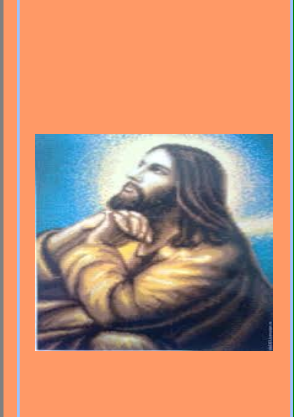

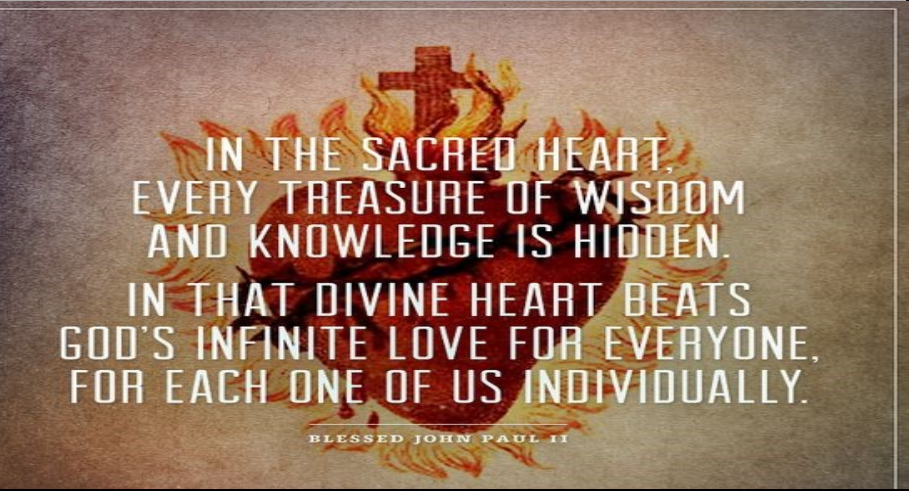

THEME: The Sacred Scriptures, Source of Wisdom

Through the media we have contact with people. Since association with people helps make us kind of persons we are, we should be selective. Youngsters whose parents do not care with whom they are associated through the media ( television, movies, books) inevitably hurt themselves. The book you read and the shows you watch reveal a great deal about you. There is an unsurpassed best-seller, known as “The Book,” the Bible. It is best-sold though probably not best-read, and certainly not best-understood.  
  
As believers we know that through this medium, the Bible, we associate with God. But we should realize that the Bible is first a human word. Which was written in a time and culture alien to us. Hence, it requires some exertion on our part to be understood. It is worthwhile to put out that effort? Yes! Because through a human word in the Bible, we discover God’s word. God inspired and guided the sacred writers!  
  
In reading the Bible, we associate with God, if we do it as it should be done, i.e., prayerfully and meditatively. Reading the Bible makes you a different person. Today’s Liturgy deals with prayer and Bible reading.
