There is a story about a boy and his father who were walking along a road when they came across a large stone. The boy said to his father, "Do you think if I use all my strength, I can move this rock?"

His father answered, "If you use all your strength, I am sure you can do it."

The boy began to push the rock. Exerting himself as much as he could, he pushed and pushed. The rock did not move. Discouraged, he said to his father, "You were wrong, I can't do it."

The father placed his arm around the boy's shoulder and said, "No, son, you didn't use all your strength — you didn't ask me to help."

A scripture verse that talks about his very kind of strength is 2nd Corinthians 12:9. It says, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." As a member of the human race it is so comforting and encouraging to know that God is tuned into our weakness and will in fact work in our weakness. There are so many times that I have not felt worthy or capable of doing a particular task that I had to do. It was this passage of scripture that I stood on and I knew that if it was going to happen, it would not be me who made it happen, rather it would be God who promises to bring His strength into the picture.

Remember the next time you get a call to do something in Emmaus that you are uncomfortable with, it could very well be God calling you to do something so that He can show His power in you.
