MEMBERS WISHING TO RECEIVE POINTS FOR ATTENDING MUST PREREGISTER BY 10/12

Divisions for Day End Awards:

Riders must choose a division at registration for day. To qualify for day-end awards for this show, riders will collect points in the indicated classes below. 1st = 5 points 2nd = 4 points 3rd = 3 points 4th = 2 points 5th = 1.

Walk/Trot Gymkhana—open to riders of any age (W/T only). Ribbons will be awarded in W/T classes 1-5.

Classes: **1, 2, 3, 4, 5**

Youth Gymkhana—open to riders 17 years of age and under as of 1/1/16

Classes: **6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16**

Adult Gymkhana—open to riders 18 years of age and over as of 1/1/16

Classes: **7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17**

General Information:

Entry Fees: \$30 for the day. Make checks payable to WRC. Any returned check shall be charged a \$30 fee.

Pre-entries are appreciated. Mail to Club 2012 Poco Farm Road Williamsport PA 17701 Attn: MS Benefit Show Chair. Postmark by 10/12.

Payback and Awards: 30% of registration is paid back to placing's 1-3 (15%-10%-5%) for Youth and Adult Divisions. Riders will obtain points for each class they place in. The top 3 in points at the end of the day in these divisions will receive payback. Top three in the Walk/Trot division will receive awards in place of money.

General Rules:

1. Signed waivers must be on file with the show secretary prior to schooling. Youth riders must have a signed waiver by parent or legal guardian in order to school or show.
2. Adding classes must be done a minimum of 2 classes in advance.
3. Under circumstances deemed unsafe by the show committee, classes may be postponed to a later date or cancelled
4. A current negative Coggins test and proof of rabies vaccination is required at registration.
5. Riders must wait until the gate is closed to begin their run.
6. Attire: Riders must wear long pants and riding shoe with heel. Short sleeves shirts are acceptable – no spaghetti strap tops.
7. No refunds for scratching a class or the entire event. Exception- unless a vet certificate is produced prior to the show.
8. Donation to NMSS can be used as a tax deduction.

Required documentation:

Current Negative Coggins and proof of rabies vaccine - required to be on the show grounds

Draw #- each rider will be assigned a random draw number generated from a computer program. This will be their order of go.

Horse / rider registration form - Used to track day end division awards and payment.

Cancellation Of Classes – Under circumstances deemed unsafe by the show committee, a class may be postponed to a later date or cancelled.

Points schedule: 1st Place= 5 points 2nd place = 4 points 3rd place = 3 points 4th place = 2 points 5th Place = 1 point.

WRC Member Overall Year End Points

WRC Members preregister by October 12th earn 10 Overall member Points. Regular points cannot be awarded due to running this event late in the year.

Conduct Expectations of Competitors - The WRC Multiple Sclerosis Benefit is meant to be a fun, family oriented and competitive environment for riders of all ages to demonstrate their horsemanship skills. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated by competitors, trainers, parents and/or spectators. This includes but is not limited to the mishandling of an equine and unacceptable language. If unsportsmanlike conduct is observed, the competitor may be asked to leave the grounds and forfeit any and all entry fees. Trainers, parents and spectators displaying such behavior will be asked to vacate the premises.
