



Dilley Ranch POA 2012 Year End Fencing Report

- 7 miles of new fencing was installed
 - 600 T posts were installed
 - 61 post holes were drilled for 6 inch wood posts
- 122 Bags of 80 lb. concrete or 5 tons were mixed and poured for wood posts
 - 10 Cross braces were drilled and installed
- Countless rolls of baling wire were used for old fence repairs
 - Countless cowboy posts and old wire were removed
- Hours of drilling, brush hogging and chain sawing were done
- Two cattle guards & wings were installed on Tibby Trail Road
 - 5 gates for property owners were installed or repaired

None of the above could have been done without the Dilley Ranch community property owners' participation. The Board members would like to personally thank all Dilley volunteers and a boundary neighbor for their hard work, input, and comradeship for this project. Thanks to the Dilley property owners that granted permission to install new fencing on their property. These actions helped all Dilley Ranch Property Owners improve the ranch grazing range land, property values, and continue our commitment to preserving our Agricultural Classification for future years. 2012 was a great start, nearly completing essential NRCS recommendations for Filing 3 & 4.
