

MINUTES OF MEETING OF FEB 10, 1995

MEETING CONVENED AT 8:30 PM. COMMANDER LEO MILHAM PRESIDING.
THIRTY ONE MEMBERS PRESENT. ROLL CALL, ABSENT NICK MASCARILLIO AND PAT MESERINDINO.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING ACCEPTED AS READ.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

MEMBERSHIP-CHARLIE FONTANA REPORTED THAT AS OF TONIGHT, WE HAVE 243 PAID MEMBERS. CHARLIE ALSO THANKED THE MEMBERS FOR THE FRUIT BASKETS AND THE TELEPHONE CALLS.

HOUSE- COMMANDER MILHAM THANKED RICHIE REICHART, GENE RAMERIZ, JERRY QUINN, WILLIE BONELLI FOR ASSISTING IN PUTTING THE BAR INTO THE KITCHEN AREA. HE INFORMED THE MEMBERS THAT WE NOW HAVE A COFFEE MACHINE AND SODA MACHINE HOOKED UP. COFFEE AND SODA WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR ALL MEMBERS USING THE POST. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU KNOW HOW TO OPERATE THE EQUIPMENT.

DUE TO THE INSTALLATION OF THIS EQUIPMENT, IT IS NECESSARY TO REVISE THE PAYMENT POLICY WITH REGARD TO RENTALS BY POST MEMBERS. RENTAL BY MEMBERS WILL NOW BE REQUIRED TO HAVE A BARTENDER AT THE COST OF \$50. HOWEVER THIS ADDITION WILL NOW INCLUDE UNLIMITED ICE, COFFEE, MILK AND SODA. THIS IS A SAVING OF \$125 FROM THE PRICE OF NON-MEMBERS. POST MEMBERS WILL BE ALLOWED TO RECEIVE THIS REDUCTION ONLY ONCE DURING A 12 MONTH PERIOD.

POST ACTIVITIES-RICHIE REICHART REPORTED THAT THE POST WILL BE HAVING A ST. PATRICK'S DAY DANCE AGAIN THIS YEAR. THE DATE FOR THE AFFAIR IS MARCH 18, 1995 STARTING AT 7PM AND THE PRICE IS \$20 PER PERSON. SINCE CHARLIE AND SAL ARE PLANNING TO BE AWAY, HE ASKED THAT THIS INFORMATION BE GIVEN TO THE MEMBERS OF THE GREAT KILLS FRIENDSHIP CLUB.

INTERFAITH BREAKFAST- GENE RAMERIZ REPORTED THAT WE WILL HAVE TEN MEMBER ATTENDING THE INTERFAITH BREAKFAST AT THE STAATEN ON SUNDAY FEB. 19, 1995.

NEW BUSINESS

COMMANDER LEO MILHAM REPORTED THAT POST WILL SPONSOR A BLOOD DRIVE WITH ASSISTANCE OF THE RED CROSS. HE HOPES TO GET OTHER POST INVOLVED AS WELL AS THE COMMUNITY. THE TENTATIVE DATE FOR THE DRIVE IS SATURDAY, APRIL 1, AT THE POST.

THE FIRST 50-50 RAFFLE RESULTED IN A COLLECTION OF \$36 WITH \$18 GOING TO THE WINNER.
