

South Dakota - Make It with Wool - 2022 Recycled, Quilt, Afghan and Novelty Contest

General Information

Contest is open to ALL residents of South Dakota. Entries may be constructed by individuals or groups and must be completed during the Jan 2020 – September 2022 time frame.

Entry fee is **\$5.00 per entry**, payable to **South Dakota MIWW**. Contestants are encouraged to submit entry forms and fees by September 15, 2022, but all items, entry forms & fees are due no later than 9:00 am on October 1, 2022 at the SD MIWW State Contest, Pierre, SD. Contestants need not be present to participate. Please attach a label to all entries.

Quilts

1. The quilt top and back must be made from 100% natural fiber fabrics. 50% of the top must be made of wool or wool blend fabrics. The remainder of the top as well as the back must be made of natural fabrics such as linen, cotton, silk, etc.
2. Batting is not required; if it is used it should be wool or other natural fiber.
3. Any construction or combination of techniques may be used (Machine and or Hand).

Categories

1. Quilt- Minimum size 36" X 42" to maximum 120" x 120"
2. Wall hanging- Minimum size 18" x 8" to maximum 36" x 42"

Afghans or Coverlets

1. Yarn or fabric must be at least 60% wool blend or specialty wool fibers, including mohair, cashmere, alpaca, camel, vicuna and llama.
2. Item may be knitted, crocheted or woven. Felting is acceptable.

Novelty Items

1. Yarn or fabric must be at least 60% wool blend or specialty wool fibers, including mohair, cashmere, alpaca, camel, vicuna and llama.
2. Item may be knitted, crocheted or woven. Felting & wool applique items are acceptable.
3. Novelty items include, but not limited to wearable accessories, home décor and artistic items.

Recycled Wool Item

1. Item must be at least 60% wool blend or specialty wool fibers.
 2. Item may be constructed from any "found" wool fabric item (clothing etc.) and remade into a new clothing item or wearable accessory.
