Hello,

Here is the sign-up stuff to get you started. We have a HUGE amount of support information for new shooters that I will not burden you with until we know what you are interested in.

Bottom line is let us get you signed up and NRA Safety Trained (each time Bill Boston and I run this course we effectively take it again ourselves and it is NEVER wasted effort believe me and is most interesting too) and out to the range to try out some fun.

We shoot rifle and pistol (usually .22 caliber as it is less costly, low noise, little recoil) at metallic silhouette round targets of 8 inch, 4 inch and 2 inch diameters. They go "plink" when hit (thus the term "plinking") and fall over so are reactive and more fun to hit than paper Bullseye targets, and they are reusable indefinitely. We also have a good shotgun shoot every Thursday at 10:00 AM followed by lunch at Bella Cuccina in Southport, and have an "open to the public" shotgun shoot one Saturday each month (check website for exact dates), also followed by lunch.

We have LOTS of inexperienced shooters, lots of ladies having a great time with us, some without their spouses, some with as a team, and we also have good long term competition shooters to coach everyone. We are informal and concentrate on FUN, but are serious about firearms safety. Not everyone on the range is NRA Safety Trained. We ALL are so trained.

Do NOT go out and purchase a firearm if you have none. Club members have the best of the best of equipment to select from and anyone will allow you to shoot their gun to try it out so you find out what you feel fits your needs best, and after that determination you will be assisted in purchasing the item selected at the best possible price and delivery too. We even have a list of recommended first guns to choose from to help out.

The sign-up forms are available on the web site. You need to join us which is cheap and includes all your NRA Materials which are first rate books and Bill and I conducting the Safety Training Course for you.
