Spices: cinnamon, cloves, chili powder, garlic powder, onion powder, cumin

Cleaning supplies: dusting clothes, dish and dishwasher soap, Mr. Clean or similar cleaning solution, paper towels, toilet paper, tissues, hand soap

And I'm sure there are items you might think of that would be help-ful too!

If each family purchases just one item, we can help them avoid the sticker shock that would accompany buying all of this type of stuff at once! Maybe you remember moving into your first home, or a new home, and all of the expense of the items it takes to get your kitchen, bath, laundry room, and window coverings all ready to go.

On the day they move in, we will tap a few of you to help them unload their stuff and we will take the items to them. Let's give them a wonderful, warm welcome as they arrive!
