WHAT OUTCOMES ARE INTENDED?

The main result of Industry 4.0 project will be the development of a course that comprises a workload of 100 hours aprox. This course will be designed including various training modules that will deal with the various aspects considered necessary for a complete understanding (not in depth) of the relevance of Industry 4.0 so that the VET student can apply the technical contents studied with a 4.0 aproach.

Moreover; an e-Repository will be developed including audiovisual and interactive tools that complement the most theoretical content.

Finally, a programmable robot will be developed that will allow the student to carry out practical training based on laboratory simulation and the design of digital manufacturing systems.

WHO LAUNCHED THIS INITIATIVE?

The Industry 4.0 consortium is made up of 8 partners from 7 European countries (Turkey, Spain, Estonia, Romania, United Kingdom, Ireland and Greece). The promoter is the Avukat Mahmut Düsün Vocational & Technical High School, involving various agents in the field of training (MBM Training & Dev. Center Ltd (UK), Dilersur Andalusia EA, SL (ESP), Aegeas Ekpaideftiki (GRE) and Estonian Fieldbus Competency Center OÜ (EST), as well as SMEs and representatives of the business sector (SC Ludor Engineering SRL (ROM), Inventya Ventures Ltd (IRE) and the Chamber of Commerce of Badajoz (ESP).
