A Day in the Life at Hannah's Hope

Ravy, the On-Site Director, has been at Hannah's Hope for 6 years. He oversees 43 children and 10 staff members. He shared a typical day at Hannah's Hope:

Everyone gets up at 6:00, showers, gets dressed, and has breakfast at 6:45. Classes start at 7:00 and finish at 10:00. Lunch occurs around 11:30. Extra classes resume in the afternoon around 2:00 until 4:00. All the children and staff have dinner around 5:30. Following dinner, Ravy says they do homework, read the Bible, and check homework again. The end of the day is spent studying the Bible before heading to bed at 9 or 9:30.
