## About the Position

The Village of Arlington Heights is accepting applications for the position of Fire Safety Inspector, who will be responsible for conducting inspections of Village buildings, structures, and systems to detect fire hazards and ensure that federal, state, and local fire codes are met. The Fire Inspector will conduct tests of fire safety systems and will assist with plan reviews for compliance with fire and life safety codes. In addition, the Fire Safety Inspector will respond to incidents which require investigative inspections.

In order to achieve fire prevention goals, the Fire Safety Inspector must be able to establish effective working relationships with property owners, occupants and the public. The Fire Safety Inspector must have knowledge of fire codes and ordinances, construction methods, and fire suppression and detection systems. While performing Village business, the Fire Safety Inspector will be provided a Village of Arlington Heights vehicle.

The minimum starting salary for this position is \$80,677 and includes a diverse and competitive benefits package, including health and dental insurance, paid vacation, and participation in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund pension plan. Qualified candidates must possess a valid Illinois Driver license, have an Associate's degree or other related technical training, and 4-6 years of experience in fire protection design, inspections, or project management. Certification by ICC or NFPA and as a School Inspector by OSFM is preferred (or have the ability to obtain within 6 months of hire). This position is open until filled.
