However...

Concerns About Revelation



- “neither apostolic nor prophetic. . . . I can in no way detect that the Holy Spirit produced it. . . . Again, they are supposed to be blessed who keep what is written in this book; and yet no one knows what that is, to say nothing of keeping it. . . . Christ is neither taught nor known in it.” (Martin Luther, 1483–1546 [1522])
- “a book of riddles that requires a Revelation to explain it” (American pamphleteer Thomas Paine, 1737–1809)
- “the most rabid outburst of vindictiveness in all recorded history” (Friedrich Nietzsche, 1844–1900)
- John the Divine’s “grandiose scheme for wiping out and annihilating everybody who wasn’t of the elect . . . and of climbing up himself right on the throne of God”; a book that “has in it none of the real Christ, none of the real Gospel” for “just as Jesus had to have a Judas . . . so did there have to be a Revelation in the New Testament” (D. H. Lawrence, 1885–1930)

Concerns About Revelation (cont'd.)




- the “curious record of the **visions of a drug addict**” (playwright George Bernard Shaw, 1856–1950)
- a “retreat from ethical responsibility” such that “its existence and its place in the canon are, in the fullest sense of the word, **evil**” (New Testament scholar Jack Sanders, 1975)
- a “**misogynist** male fantasy at the end of time” (feminist New Testament scholar Tina Pippin, 1992)
- a book that transforms the “nonviolent resistance of the slaughtered Jesus into the **violent warfare of the slaughtering Jesus**” (NT scholar John Dominic Crossan, 2007)

Common Misunderstandings about Revelation

- “Apocalypse” means end-of-the-world destruction.
- Revelation gives us an outline of history and/or the future; we can find current events predicted in Rev.
- The Bible (incl. Rev) is full of puzzle pieces to be assembled.
- Rev predicts the rapture.
- Rev predicts the coming of the antichrist.
- Wars and rumors of wars are good things because they may signal the imminent end.
- Rev says God will destroy the earth, possibly by nuclear war, so don’t be concerned about nuclear arms or the environment.
- The mission of the church is to get people ready for the rapture.
- When Jesus returns, he will destroy all his enemies (non-believers).







The Basic Scheme of Dispensationalist Reading of Revelation




The Mixed ("Hybrid") Literary Character of Revelation (see Rev 1:1-8)



- **Apocalypse**: unveiling, dualism, symbolism, politics, hope
 - like a series of political cartoons*
 - prophecy in a new key
 - crisis literature, resistance literature
- **Prophecy**: judgment and salvation; the word of God for the people of God; see 1:3; 22:7, 10, 18, 19
- **Letter**: a "word on target" for real people, real churches

* and not unlike both poetry and science fiction

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
What and Where was Babylon?




- Located in Mesopotamia, the land between the Tigris and the Euphrates (= present-day Iraq)



Dea Roma on 7 Hills, coin under Vespasian, ruled 69-79




The 7 Hills of Rome and the Tiber



- Revelation 1–3 / Opening Vision of the Risen Lord and His Seven Pastoral-Prophetic Messages
- Revelation 4–5 / Central and Centering Vision of God and the Lamb
- Revelation 6–20 / Visions of the Judgment of God, with Interludes
- Revelation 21–22 / Final Vision of the New Creation

A Tale/Battle of Two Truth Claims

Rome's Myths (Fake News)

- Empire of Rome
- Emperor is Lord/God/Son of God/Savior/Father/King of Kings
- The Roman *Pax*
- *Victoria*
- Faith (= loyalty to Caesar/Rome)
- Eternity


Revelation's Counter-Claims (Good News)

- Empire of God
- Jesus/God alone deserves and rightly has these titles
- "Babylon's" culture of death
- Victory of the Lamb & his followers
- Faithfulness of Jesus, and of his followers to him
- Eternal rule of God/Lamb/saints

The Unholy Trinity of Revelation 12-13: Reading at Two Levels

■ Dragon

- Satan
- Power(s) of evil behind global political, economic, and military power

■ Beast from the Sea (mortal wound, 666)

- Roman imperial power/the emperor
- Global political, economic, and military power or system

■ Beast from the Land

- Priesthood of Roman imperial cult
- Religious support of and propaganda for global political, economic, and military power or system

1. The Greek for Nero Caesar, *nerōn kaisar*, transliterates into Hebrew as NRWN QSR (reading right to left) and, using Hebrew gematria, with the conventional number values as shown below, adds up to 666:

SUM	Resh (ר)	Samech (ס)	Qof (ק)	Nun (נ/ן)	Waw (ו)	Resh (ר)	Nun (נ/ן)

2. The same two words can also be transliterated without the final “n” in *nerōn* into Hebrew as NRW QSR:

So, what are we to do with Revelation?...

Theological Features of Revelation

- A Call to First-Commandment **Faithfulness**
 - Not widespread persecution but **widespread accommodation**
- Therefore, a **Liturgical** Text (worship)
 - Full of hymns; 7 beatitudes
- Therefore, a **Political** Text (idolatry as a political act)
 - a manifesto against **civil religion**, specifically the imperial cult, and associated or and similar practices
 - a manifesto against **any "-ism" that claims to offer that which God alone can provide** (peace, security, life, etc.)
 - a manifesto against any **power that does evil in the name of good or God**

Lamb-Centered

- Worthy is the Lamb!
- The Lamb appears 28 times (7= fullness x 4 = universality).
- The Lamb reconfigures God: God crucified, God cross-shaped
- Lamb power
- Jesus as faithful witness (1:5), the church as faithful witness
 - Revelation 12:11—But they have conquered him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they did not cling to life even in the face of death.

Reading Revelation Responsibly

“looking for parallels rather than predictions”

“performing the text rather than decoding it”


Civil Religion/Religious Nationalism

- The **attribution of sacred status to secular power** (normally the state and/or its head) as the source of divine blessing, requiring **devotion and allegiance of heart, mind, and body to the sacred-secular power and its values**, all expressed in various narratives, other texts, rituals, and media that reinforce both the secular power's sacred status and the beneficiaries' sacred duty of devotion and allegiance, even to the point of death.
 - The God of civil religion is **generic** (little reference to Jesus) but tribal (lots of references to national heroes).
 - Civil religion occurs **both inside and outside houses of worship**.

Elements of American Civil Religion: Americanism/American Exceptionalism

- America as a nation chosen by God
- America as a messianic figure (world savior)
- America as greatest nation on earth
- American military, economic, and political power as God's blessing and power
- Allegiance, duty to country as a sacred obligation to God
- American wars as sacred, redemptive violence

The Total Claims of the Modern State

- [The modern, industrialized state] claims to be the basis of not only the freedom but the very life of its citizens, or in the case of the messianic exceptionalism of the US, the life of the whole world. What constitutes the established justification of mass organized killing and accelerated death is thus a threat to the modern state particularly *as the guarantor of freedom and life*. So totalized is the modern, industrialized state that we supposedly cannot expect any of the benefits associated with it, say, the collective alleviation of poverty or the provision of medical care or relief from natural disaster or economic regulation, without accepting the massive costs it exacts by violence.

The Church: All Peoples & Tongues (Rev 7)

- ⁴And I heard the number of those who were sealed, one hundred forty-four thousand, sealed out of every tribe of the people of Israel.... ⁹After this I looked, and there was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, robed in white, with palm branches in their hands. ¹⁰They cried out in a loud voice, saying, "Salvation belongs to our God who is seated on the throne, and to the Lamb!" ¹¹And all the angels stood around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures, and they fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, ¹²singing, "Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and might be to our God forever and ever! Amen."

Hope for the New Creation (Isaiah 25)

- ⁶On this mountain the Lord of hosts will make for all peoples a feast of rich food, a feast of well-aged wines, of rich food filled with marrow, of well-aged wines strained clear. ⁷And he will destroy on this mountain the shroud that is cast over all peoples, the sheet that is spread over all nations; he will swallow up death forever. ⁸Then the Lord God will wipe away the tears from all faces, and the disgrace of his people he will take away from all the earth, for the Lord has spoken.

Hope for the New Creation (Isaiah 60)

- ¹⁸Violence shall no more be heard in your land, devastation or destruction within your borders; you shall call your walls Salvation, and your gates Praise. ¹⁹The sun shall no longer be your light by day, nor for brightness shall the moon give light to you by night; but the Lord will be your everlasting light, and your God will be your glory. ²⁰Your sun shall no more go down, or your moon withdraw itself; for the Lord will be your everlasting light, and your days of mourning shall be ended.
