

Woodlands Baseball Academy – COVID-19 Response

Woodlands Baseball Academy has made every effort to mitigate possible exposure or transmission of any contagious agent at the facility. Even before the mandated shutdown of Montgomery County, we began to limit the number of persons entering the Indoor Batting Cage Facility and used disinfection measures. As we open back up to the public we will continue with these same measures as follows:

- The common area of the Indoor Batting cages is closed off. Please enter on the left side of the building.
- Please use the restroom at home before your lesson or rental. Restrooms will be closed to the public until further notice.
- Two persons per cage allowed inside. Ex: One coach + one player; one Parent + one player; two players per cage.
- No more than 8 persons should be inside the indoor cages at one time.
- Team cage rentals will need to stay in the outdoor cages.
- Family members can wait outside while their child completes their lesson or cage rental. Picnic benches available.
- A Handwashing Station is available outside the Indoor Batting cages. We encourage all players to wash hands before and after their lesson or cage rental.
- Effective June 2, 2020...Governor Abbotts Order mandates: Masks are required inside the building. If you are outside and within six feet of persons who are not in your household, masks are required per the state rule. Woodlands Baseball Academy will not be enforcing the wearing of masks. We do not have a mandate as a business to monitor the wearing of masks. Masks are a personal responsibility and you will choose whether to comply with the mandate by Governor Abbott at your own risk.
- Players and Coaches/Parents engaged in physical activity outside are not required by the state to wear a mask.
- Coaches and players are encouraged to wipe down baseballs that are used between clients with a 10% bleach solution. (Be careful not to drip on clothes). We are providing bleach solution and rags in buckets.
- Teams are encouraged to work in smaller groups of players and to employ social distancing as much as possible.
- Montgomery County is EXEMPT from the 10 person rule per an executive order by Montgomery County Judge Keough. People may congregate outside as they wish.

We ask all coaches and players – if you are ill, please do not come to the facility.

If you or a family member had an active case of Covid-19 and were at Woodlands Baseball Academy during that time, please let your coach know immediately via phone or text.

For all players who are actively around teammates or other persons in public, Texas guidelines by Governor Abbott encourage you to stay clear of relatives or friends older than 65 years old for a period of 14 days.
