## 2018 Roof Sit Team Guidelines & Roof Sit Rules

The 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Roof Sit will be held at McDonald's Food & Family Center in Bad Axe on February 2, 2018 from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm. **Our goal is \$12,000!**

Each team shall consist of 4-6 volunteers to help at the Roof Sit in various stations and sit on the roof. Team registrations are due to the Council by January 23, 2018.

Many teams make tremendous fundraising efforts and for that we are grateful. Please bring in your team's funds in any fashion you choose on the day of the event. After all, every penny counts!

Each team must have at least one person on the roof at all times during their designated hour. A team may only have up to two (2) roof sitters on the roof at one time. Roof sitters must be at least 18 years old and must sign the "Registration and Waiver" upon arrival at event.

Each team is encouraged to name one (or more!) member of their team who will talk to the radio stations at the event for the live remote broadcast. This is a great opportunity to promote your group's community involvement as CA/N Council Roof Sitters!

As weather cannot be predicted, roof sitters are encouraged to dress warmly for their time on the roof. The Roof Sit will be canceled if Bad Axe Public Schools are canceled due to inclement weather. In case of cancellation, February 9, 2018 will be the alternate date of the event.

Funds raised can be sent to the Council until February 28, 2018 to be counted toward awards. Please mail your funds to: Huron County CA/N Council, PO Box 332, Bad Axe, MI 48413. You may also call (989) 550-6261 to arrange a drop-off of cash.

Teams are encouraged to bring a team banner, table decorations, team matching clothes or accessories to help them promote their team and encourage donations. It is also recommended that teams who wish to continue to solicit that day bring additional canisters, as the only ones available will be at the designated tables. It is advised that everything be done in good taste.
