



#### Sheridan Fire Department Newsletter November 2022

The Sheridan Fire Department has had another busy year in 2022. The biggest projects we did at the station in 2022 were getting the floors painted with epoxy floor coating by Central Illinois Coating. The walls were also epoxy painted by fire department staff. We had the land-scaping redone in front of station, with new mulch and trim around the area. We worked with AMEREN to get all lighting LED at the department now, FICEK Electric did the work. All new LED bulbs were installed in the truck bay along with 4 new LED Bullard light poles in front of the station.







The district is currently in the process of ordering a new LUCAS Device. This device is for doing uninterrupted CPR on a patient that is in full cardiac arrest. It is an automated device that does CPR on a patient while EMTs can do other treatment on this patient. Due to the shortage of staffing, this is a good investment for the departments. Both Serena and Sheridan staff will be trained on this device before its put into use. Delivery date is about June 2023. The Sheridan and Serena Fire Departments were awarded a \$10,000 Grant from COMPEER as part of multi department grant that was available. The unit will cost approximately \$24,000 which includes a 5-year maintenance plan for parts and repair. Serena and Sheridan Fire Departments will split the balance for payment. All Donations Sheridan Ambulance received in 2020/2021 will go towards the purchase of this LUCAS Device.

The Sheridan Fire Department have just recently purchased 2 new Life Pak 15 D Fib Units. These units will replace the outdated units we currently have. One of the unit's computer board burnt up in it and of course cannot be replaced. Once again, this equipment is not cheap as these units will cost the department \$57,000 total with maintenance plan for parts and repair. Due the demand and what other supply shortage, these units will not arrive until about August 2023.

Sheridan and Serena Fire Departments also went in on the purchase of a UTV with trailer to haul it. This UTV is a brush fire unit along with the capability of carrying a patient in a stokes basket, stretcher from places where ambulances can't get to. This unit will be stationed in Serena and be available to both departments and mutual aid departments. Sheridan donated \$5000.00 towards this unit along with some other items that won't need to be purchased. This unit cost approx. \$39,000.

Illinois Public Risk Fund awarded the Sheridan Fire Department at \$2773.00 Safety Grant available in January 2023. This grant will be used for training items for the department.

Sheridan has applied for the Office of the State Fire Marshall Truck Revolving Loan Program for \$350,000. If the District is elected to get this interest free, 20-year loan, we will start looking for a new or used fire engine. Currently, new pumper engines are anywhere from \$600,000 to \$750,000 depending on what meets your department needs. Of course, every few months the prices are going up. As of Mid-December, prices will jump about \$60,000 on a new pumper. So, we will be doing some exploring if this becomes a reality. There is a 2-year lead time on new trucks, so if we ordered one after the 1st of the year, we would expect in in 2025 some time.

We have also completed the process for specking out a new ambulance for the department. The district purchased a new one in 2020 for the cost of about \$305,000.00. This same ambulance will cost about \$350,000 to \$360,000 now. The lead time on this ambulance is about 2 years also. Who knows what the final price will be in the 2-year wait time. The ambulance we will be getting rid of will be 20 years old by the time we receive the new one, if the board decides to go ahead with the purchase.


The Department currently only has 14 members on the roster. Like everyone else in this field of work, help is hard to come by. We have been pretty fortunate at Sheridan to operate with all part time staffing. But this won't last forever. We are starting to explore options for the department for coverage. We are always looking for new members. Anyone that is interested in becoming a member, Firefighter and or EMT please contact the station at 815-496-2296, ask for Asst. Chief Kyle Cook. Sheridan averages about 450 calls annually between fire and ambulance responses, with about 70% of the calls during the daytime and 30% during nighttime. For the residents that don't know, Sheridan has 2 FF/EMTs on duty from 7 am to 7 pm, and 2 FF/EMTs on call from 7 pm to 7am 365 days a year. As I said it's all covered with part time staffing. Sheridan Ambulance also covers the Serena Fire District for ambulance service, approx. 130 square miles along with 14 sq miles for Sheridan Fire District.




