

Registration instructions

- When entering the tournament you will need to join the team that your team captain sets up. If the event is a Festival or Open then any team or player may enter the tournament. To enter a Championship you will need to finish 1st or 2nd in a Festival or 1st-4th in an Open. Rankings and qualifiers are updated weekly online.
- Team parents will enter a team name (get creative, i.e. Nadal's Bulls, Mountain Men, etc.) and choose a division. After choosing a division, the team parent will enter under that team name and pay at that time. 3v3wtt will send each of the team members a waiver form to sign and bring to the tournament desk. Team captains will be able to see the team and which members have entered.
- Teams that have advanced players (ranked) should enter the GOLD division and teams that have less experienced or intermediate level players (unranked) should enter the SILVER division.
- Players are not allowed to play on 2 separate teams as scheduling would be impossible to complete with the quick round format.
- Players may play in an age division as long as they qualify and do not age up in the month of the tournament. Players may be required to submit proof of age.

Rules and format

- 3v3 World Tennis Tour was created to give players more opportunities to play multiple matches in a quick round format.
- Teams need a minimum of 3 players with a maximum of 4.
- Format of play will be Team A vs Team B in 1 singles and 1 doubles match in each round. Each match is a 32 total points pro set. At the end of the match the cumulative score of both players will be 32, (ex. 17-15, 19-13).
- After a 5 minute warm-up, players will spin for serve. Players will alternate serve every 4 points and switch sides of the court when the total score adds up

- to 16. Each round will last approximately 20-25 minutes. Each new round must have a different singles player before you can repeat players.
- Teams will first compete in pool play (round robin) with the other teams in their flight. After pool play, teams will be ranked based on total points won and will begin draw play. Draw play will determine the final standings for the tournament. In the draw play, players may repeat lines in each round.
- Teams should plan on playing throughout the day. Play will consist of both morning and afternoon matches.
- Coaching by the team captain or designated coach is allowed on the 1 minute changeover at 16 points.
- Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place.
- Positive cheering is encouraged in between points (it's a team event!!).

Ranking points will be given based on the following point scale.
