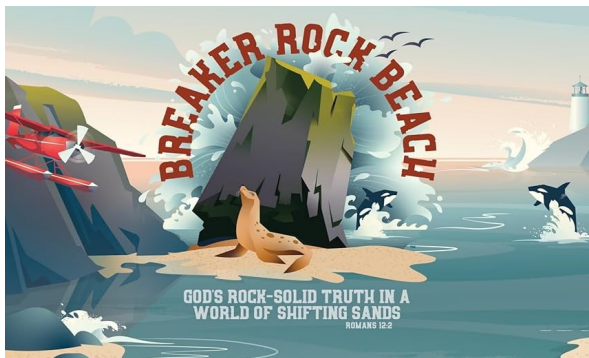
LCMS National Youth Gathering 2025 Info

If you or your child are interested in attending the LCMS Nation Youth Gathering in New Orleans July 19-23, 2025, please let Heraleen or Donnie know asap. There is a sign up sheet in the back of the sanctuary.

Youth must be 14-20 to attend. Registration is \$395 per person (until **Nov 1, 2024**) and then goes up. Hotel, travel and meal costs are not included in the registration fee. We are estimating that it will cost approx. \$1000 total per child, and will be doing fundraisers to help raise money.

Those 21 and older can be leaders. Minimum of 2 adults are required with a group and varies by participants.

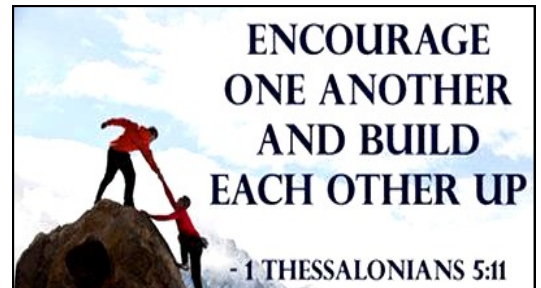
