The Wellington at Saratoga HOA Board of Directors approves the following changes to Rule 5.6.vii.1 and establishes the following pool rules:

Rule 5.6.vii.1

a. Only residents and their accompanied guests are permitted to use the Wellington at Saratoga pool grounds. No one under the age of 16 is permitted at the pool unless accompanied by an adult resident.

b. A resident may bring no more than four (4) guests per household Monday through Friday and after 2:00pm on weekends and holidays.

c. The pool is for the use of Residents only before 2:00pm on weekends and holidays.

d. Any resident violating this rule will be given a written notice on the first violation and a \$50.00 assessment for each subsequent violation.

Definitions:

Resident: A "resident" is defined as the deeded homeowner, their spouses and/or dependents.

Dependent: A "dependent" is defined as a permanent resident of the home and/or any individual that is wholly supported by a Resident, financially or otherwise.

Guest: A "guest" is defined as any individual that is not a resident.

Wellington Pool Rules*

- 1) The pool area is open dawn to dusk.
- 2) Guests must be accompanied at all times by a Wellington resident over the age of 18. Each residence may have up to 4 guests M-F or after 2:00pm on weekends and holidays. The pool is reserved for residents' use only until 2:00pm on weekends and holidays.
- 3) No pets are permitted inside the fenced pool area.
- 4) A resident over the age of 18 must accompany all children under the age of 16. Children in diapers must wear a "swim" diaper. Diapers cannot be changed poolside.
- 5) Only swimwear may be worn in the pool. Street clothes may be worn on the pool deck or restrooms but not in the swimming pool.
- 6) No glass containers are allowed in the fenced pool area. Drinks brought to the pool must be in unbreakable containers. Food is permitted on the pool deck only, not in the swimming pool.
- 7) Residents have a responsibility to all pool users to encourage safe and courteous behavior. Please speak up respectfully if you observe dangerous or inappropriate behavior.
- 8) Please pick up and clean up the pool area before leaving. Also make sure the restroom doors and gates are closed and locked.
