

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO  
ORDINANCE O-2014-32**

**AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S PROBATIONARY APPOINTMENT  
OF PATRICK T. KUHL AS A PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER FOR THE AMELIA  
VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Amelia Village has a vacancy in its Police Department for a part time police officer, and;

**WHEREAS**, based on the recommendation of the Police Chief, the Mayor desires to appoint Patrick T. Kuhl to fill the vacancy as a probationary part-time police officer, and;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that:

**SECTION I.** Based on the Police Chief's recommendation, the Mayor does hereby appoint Patrick T. Kuhl to fill the vacant part-time police officer position as a probationary part-time police officer.

**SECTION II.** Village Council does hereby confirm the Mayors probationary appointment.

**SECTION III.** That probationary period for Patrick T. Kuhl shall be not more than six (6) months to determine the appointee's capacity to discharge the duties, powers, and functions of a part-time Amelia Police Officer.

**SECTION IV.** That upon satisfactory completion of probation, the Police Chief may recommend to the Mayor that the appointee be removed from probationary part-time police officer status and assigned to regular part time status.

**SECTION V.** At the end of the six (6) month probationary period if the appointee has not made satisfactory progress the Police Chief may recommend to the Mayor that the employee be discharged.

**SECTION VI.** That Patrick T. Kuhl shall be hired at the status of a part-time probationary police officer and said beginning salary shall be set at eleven dollars and 50 cents (\$11.50) per hour during the employee's probationary period.

**SECTION VII.** Pursuant to Section 701, Work Hours, of the *Amelia Village Personnel Policy Manual* Part-time police officers are required to work a minimum of two shifts per work period. Additional hours may be authorized by the Police Chief or the Mayor as the needs of the Village may dictate.

**SECTION VIII.** That the position of part-time police officer shall be considered a part-time position and shall be subject to all rules and regulations of the Village and all departmental policies and procedures as developed by the police department.

**SECTION IX.** That the Amelia Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION X.** This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency which is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare. The reason for such necessity is that the Police Department of Amelia Village has recently lost several police officers and this appointment will allow the Village to provide the necessary police protection to the citizens of the Village. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MRS. GERBER moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.

MR. CAMPBELL seconded the motion.
