

# ROBERT BRUCE DEVROYE

1893 - 1985

Robert Bruce Devroye, age 92, of Caseville, died Monday, July 15 at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon.

He was born March 28, 1893 in Manistique, son of the late Joseph and Florence (Lockhart) Devroye. In 1921 he moved to Caseville where he was an auto mechanic until 1952 when he opened and operated Thompson Boat Sales until he retired in 1975.
