Most people avoid dealing with their character, possibly assuming that if they think it, then it must be correct; how do we begin to allow God to direct where I need growth, rather than "accepting who I am" and risking a spiritual stagnation (and failing to mature in our Christianity)?

Is there one or two points in this sermon that resonate with you? Will you pray for God's help to "know how to think about it" and what He would have you focus on to change? (see James 1 (this would be wisdom- how to think and what to do))
