Each Discipline costs \$30. This covers all Match Scores (there are 3 matches to shoot, and they are like virtual competitions against 4-Hers from around the state) and the cost of registration for the state shoot.

You must have had BB Gun for at least one year or be 12 years old to be able to shoot Air Pistol or Air Rifle. You must have shot Air Pistol for at least one year and be 12 (4-H age) to be able to shoot .22 Pistol. You must have had at least one year of BB Gun or Air Rifle and be 12 (4-H age) to shoot .22 Rifle. Individual discipline instructors have final say on who gets to shoot.

Safety Glasses are required for EVERYONE (this includes coaches) on the firing line. It is recommended that you bring your own. TCSS does have some that can be borrowed for practice, but they are not the best. Also, it is recommended to have 8x binoculars for BB Gun. No Boots on the BB Gun line. For .22 shooters ear protection is also required.

Shooting Sports Shirt: If anyone is interested in the green/white Tripp County Shooting Sports shirt they will cost \$27.50 each. The shirts were designed, and cost shared by Pheasants Forever through our Midway USA Adopt a Team Trust Fund, where we can use up to 5% of our account.

To complete their shooting sports project the participants must attend at least 50% of all practices/meetings. Be on TIME. If you are late, it will be up to the range officer to decide if you may shoot on that line. If you are on the first line, be there 20 minutes early to help set up. Shooters on the last line of the night will stay and help clean up. All participants coming into the building please be courteous to shooters that are still practicing. Be quiet and remain behind the scoring tables. Do not forget to SIGN IN AS SOON AS YOU ARRIVE. **Please call if you are unable to attend practice or have any questions. 4-H Center: 842-1155.** Let it ring a long time... It's a long way to the phone.

Cancellation Policy: There will be Shooting Sports every Thursday even if school is not scheduled. Shooting Sports will ONLY be canceled if school in Winner is called off/canceled due to weather.
