Thank you for the opportunity to be your pastor these three years. You have been loving, gracious, merciful, receptive, responsive, productive, and life-giving. Together we have accomplished much for the Kingdom of God. Before the pandemic we had largely resolved the financial difficulties the church was facing. Pledges and gifts increased, followed by Miracle Sunday and the funds to repair the Family Life Center and Fellowship Hall/Education buildings. They are beautiful again, and hosting life-changing ministry. The long-dreamed-of youth ministry is vital and growing – 41 youth last week! Souls are being fed through several vital ministries. You supported me through my hearing rehab, and I will always remember your grace and understanding through that ordeal.

I have been in vocational ministry for 32 years, the last 3 with inadequate hearing. I realized during the pandemic shutdown that I simply cannot continue without adequate hearing and have accepted Disability/Retirement as the best option for me and for you. I look forward to being able to focus on things I CAN do rather than struggling to do the things I CAN'T. I look forward to watching you from afar as you thrive under the leadership of Rev. Brian Coplin along with his sweet family, and I celebrate with you that there will again be a FAMILY in the parsonage. You have waited a long time for that!

Your lay leadership is working hard along with me to prepare the church for its future. The Church Transformation Team is receiving recommendations for some new direction and ministry tweaking through its work with the Conference team. These are good ideas based on our workshops, conversations, and the church-wide workshop held in April. I pray that you will receive these recommendations as God-breathed and Spirit-filled – which they are – and that you will continue the work we have started.

My last Sunday is June 13. Rev. Coplin's first Sunday is July 4. Rev. Ray Spiller will preach the two interim Sundays; his wisdom is always both welcome and helpful.

My love and prayers for you will continue, as I pray yours will for me. Listen to the Lord and follow His expressed will – and all shall be well.

I leave you with love in my heart and the confidence of hope in my soul.

get ready to beautify our church grounds.




