Hello everyone, I have been on a small reprieve while the Lord was teaching me something very important and now I want to share with everyone. Recently I have been dealing with what defines a Christian and how to share the Gospel.

Clare's ministry has been very enlightening to me personally but I am being pulled to understand how to approach people both in 1on1 and in congregation bodies. From this experience two very distinct topics came up and I want to share both in hopes it encourages your walks with Jesus.

Topic 1

Gentle Jesus Vs Convicting Jesus.

This was a very interesting lesson that Jesus taught me. I had to suffer in order to understand this but the fruit is in who it can help going forward. We often get caught up in either what is right or wrong or how to present Jesus to others. Sometimes we can seek to be so sinless that we feel everyone should be at our same level of sin relationship. Many preachers I have heard online and in person all portray conviction or encouragement or whatever. They approach Jesus as religion or a set of rules. Jesus is not any of this. I bring this up because there are people out there who attack Clare or her ministry claiming that she isn't following God. What I experienced first hand with Jesus is when we make Jesus out to be a convicting God who points out sin and does things in a certain way, He will reflect that back on us.

The Jesus we portray to others through our life examples will become a trial in our life. What does this mean? Many people online will place Jesus in this box of being untouchable and so Holy that no one can go near and we should all fear and He won't talk to us and so forth. Those people get a tough hurdle to get over as they either have to repent of this ideology or their lives will start to be molded this way as a trial so they can see Jesus love first hand. It is hard to explain in short form, but basically be careful how you present Jesus because it is a reflection of your personal relationship with Him.

With this He also told me to not watch anymore preachers or messages from others outside of Clare or another He may reveal later. Reason being all those opinions from them go into the pool of ideas that reflect Jesus. We want a pure Jesus, so we should only seek Jesus to know Jesus. I ask you all to go before Jesus and ask Him to explain this better because I feel it is important going forward.

Topic 2

How to share the Gospel.

The Gospel is actually very simple to share. I had thought it would be hard or this elaborate message but it really is easy. We all know we must repent and believe in the Gospel, (His work). But when we share it, our lives are what give it power through us. This means Holy Spirit works best through us not by the words we say but by our sanctification. The more Christ like we are the more power His Cross has through us. We don't want to bring religion or Christian ideals. All these actually cause division.

We are all sinners and Christ died for us all. We can encourage others to follow Jesus and help bridge the gap to start that relationship, all while ignoring their sins, modern church ideals, and theology. Bringing the Love of Jesus to others is about spoiling the efforts the enemy has had on the body. Call for unity, brother/sisterly love and a focus solely on Him. This is not the kind of message I have heard in a Sunday church but it exalts the power of the cross and opens people up to Holy Spirit. In short your actions are going to spread the Gospel more than your words, the Gospel is the Love of God.

A love that can only be shown through our lives not just our words. I was also lead to understand the reason why there are no more apostles is because what should be considered is now written. Teachers who come in and explain things aren't what is needed any more, disciples are. Being those living in the will of Jesus, following Him daily, this is the most powerful way to spread the Gospel. In short what this all means, if I am correct the reason why Clare's ministry focuses so much on our character before Jesus is because that is the most powerful way to spread the Gospel. It is living a life that relies totally on the goodness and supernatural movement of Holy Spirit to change lives. Why so many push back from my limited understanding is we live in an age where people believe their decisions are what bring salvation to them. Those who follow this channel and practice what is said here know that Holy Spirit is powerful and very much moving in people's lives.
