

This month in Marine Corps History

August 4, 1900

Marines lifted siege of Peking

Marines in International Relief Force marched out of Tientsin to lift siege of Peking. Marine Pvt. Dan Daly won first of two Congressional Medals of Honor.

August 14, 1912

Marines landed in Nicaragua

Maj. Smedley D. Butler led marines ashore, beginning intervention in Nicaragua.

August 14, 1912

Marines landed at Veracruz, Mexico

Marine regiments landed at Veracruz, Mexico, to keep German guns from Mexican dictator Porfirio Díaz.

August 7, 1942

1st Marine Division landed on Guadalcanal

Guadalcanal became the first major American offensive of World War II, which began the U.S. Island Hopping campaign. That operation won the division its first of three World War II Presidential Unit Citations.

August 17, 1942

2nd Raider Battalion raided Makin Atoll

The objectives of the Makin Atoll operation were diverse: to destroy installations, take prisoners, gain intelligence on the area, and divert Japanese attention and reinforcements from Guadalcanal and Tulagi.

August 2, 1950

Marines landed at Pusan

1st Marine Provisional Brigade landed at Pusan, South Korea.

August 8, 1974

Nixon forced to resign

Due to the Watergate Scandal, President Nixon resigned the most powerful office on the planet. Incoming president Gerald R. Ford pardoned him. **Don Lyon** graduated from boot camp at MCRD San Diego. (shit have to learn a whole new chain of command)

August 19, 1974

Marines defended Cyprus embassy Marines

defended U.S. embassy in Nicosia, Cyprus, after sniper killed U.S. ambassador Roger Davies; mob action ensued.

August 5, 1990

Marines saved Liberian civilians

Marines landed in Monrovia, Liberia, and evacuated civilians threatened by civil war.

Sergeant Major Troy E. Black Becomes the 19th Sergeant Major of the Marine Corps

Sergeant Major Troy E. Black received the Sword of Office from Sergeant Major Ronald L. Green during a Relief and Appointment ceremony at Marine Barracks Washington, July 26, signifying his new position as the 19th Sergeant Major of the Marine Corps.

Black, a Louisville, Kentucky native and 31-year Marine veteran, assumes responsibility as the senior ranking enlisted Marine in the Corps.

"I am proud of our Corps and our Marines," said Black. "I look forward to serving the Marines, Sailors and families that dedicate themselves to the Corps every day."

Green, a Jackson, Mississippi native, turned over his responsibilities after serving as the 18th Sergeant Major of the Marine Corps since 2015.

During his time as Sergeant Major of the Marine Corps, Green worked hard to assist the Commandant in improving lethality through innovative training, increasing educational opportunities for enlisted Marines, and advocating for Marine and Family resources.

"I want to thank all the Marines, Civilian Marines, Sailors, families and everyone who supports our Corps every day," said Green. "It has been an honor to serve as the 18th Sergeant Major of the Marine Corps. Though I am no longer in the game, I will be cheering from the sidelines. Take care of our Corps, your fellow Marines, your families and yourselves. Semper Fidelis."
