Founded in 1957, Bradley Hills Presbyterian Church Nursery School (BHPCNS), a mission of Bradley Hills Presbyterian Church (BHPC), nurtures all aspects of a child's growth through an age-appropriate play-based program. Since our establishment, BHPCNS has been guided by our mission, core values, and faith traditions, and balanced by our commitment to continual learning, innovation, and adaptation.

The BHPCNS 2022-2027 Strategic Plan builds on strong adherence to our Play. Grow. Learn. philosophy, proven institutional strengths, and the support of our nurturing community. At the same time, it seeks to integrate new research, emerging best practices, and opportunities to better leverage our campus amenities, while responding to the dynamic environment.

In the fall of 2019, BHPCNS embarked on a comprehensive planning process to further enhance our program and promote the value of the BHPCNS experience. Led by the Long-Term Planning Committee, the development of the Strategic Plan was the result of a multi-year collaborative process to collect and consider feedback from current and past parents, administrators, faculty, and Board members. The strategic planning process coincided with the emergence of COVID-19 in March 2020, and as a result, the plan included strategies for the continued operation of the school, not only during the COVID pandemic but looking ahead to the future. In 2022, the Strategic Plan was finalized as BHPCNS prepares to begin implementing the strategic goals and objectives during the 2022-2023 school year.

Our children learn through free play, arts and crafts, individual and communal projects, dramatic play, literature, music, science, foreign language, and creative movement.

- Develop policies to promote good health practices and to protect the facility and the people within it
 - Interpret and implement health and safety requirements as specified by state and local government standards*
 - Provide health/safety training for the BHPCNS community
 - Invest in equipment to promote health and hygienic practices

Advance a play-based program of excellence designed to support a child's social, emotional, and academic developmental needs, laying the foundation for love of learning.

- Utilize developmentally age-appropriate milestones to align curriculum guidelines, reflecting current best practices
- Promote student growth through methods of differentiated instruction to meet the varied needs of each child socially, emotionally, cognitively, and physically
 - Integrate with sensory and outdoor play
 - Strengthen enrichment opportunities
- Ensure a top-quality professional development program to provide faculty and staff the education, skills, and tools to achieve curriculum goals
- Continue to attract and retain outstanding staff by enhancing ways in which we cultivate and celebrate excellence
- Consistently articulate the importance and application of a play-based curriculum
