Thank you to those who helped with funerals for Ryan Sestak and Agnes Kocer. Your help is much appreciated by the family and friends of both families. Please note that next weekend, we will be swapping Mass times on Sunday to accommodate Bishop Swain's schedule for the 100th anniversary celebration of Saint John the Baptist Church in Lesterville. Mass will be at 8:30 in Tabor and at 10:30 in Lesterville. Mass for Saint John the Baptist parish will be at Lesterville, the 1st, 2nd, and 5th Sundays of the month and at Sigel on the 3rd and 4th Sundays. The next few weeks will be busy with celebrations at Lesterville and Czech Days in Tabor and I am praying for good weather for both events. Now that summer is in full force, I would like to extend an invitation to each of you to consider attending daily Mass. In July, I will begin offering a daily Mass for Saint John the Baptist parish on Thursday evening at 7:00 pm and we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 6:00 pm to shortly before Mass beginning and I will be available for confession during that time. We will follow the custom of having Mass at the church that had the Sunday Mass at the beginning of the week. I will still celebrate Mass in Tabor at 8:30. In July, I will also begin offering a Mass on the first Saturday of the month to introduce the tradition of honoring Mary on Saturday. This will happen at 9:00 am and I will rotate it to each church as we go through the months. As a rule of thumb, if there is a funeral on any day the morning Mass will not be celebrated in Tabor aside from Wednesday because Mass is scheduled for 5:30 pm.

From time to time I include some words about our identity as sons and daughters of God the Father in my homilies. Our identity is very important because it tells us something about ourselves but it also tells others about who we are as individuals and on a broader scale as farmers, teachers, nurses, etc. Our personal identity is what makes us unique from every other person that has existed or will exist. Each of us is unique and unrepeatable. What happens when our identity as Catholics is threatened from outside forces? What happens when a Catholic or Christian adoption agency is forced to place children with same sex couples or go out of business? Does that agency compromise on their belief in marriage as between one man and one woman and the reality that a child needs both a mother and a father? In 2011 Catholic adoption agencies in Illinois shut down because they did want to compromise their faith. In the last month several states have signed into law bills that will prohibit abortions and several celebrities and companies have vowed to boycott industries within each state. Another question that we need to ask is how is my identity as a Catholic threatened by my own actions. When a person knowingly and willingly skips Mass on a Sunday or Holy Day they should approach confession as soon as possible. A while ago someone called asking for financial assistance for a hotel room in Yankton and as they listened to the answering machine for the rectory she noticed that I listed the confessions times for both parishes and she made the remark: "Catholics still do that?" I answered politely that people still sin so we still need confession. In the coming months, I am going to try to offer different times for confession to make it a little more accessible to people in both parishes. ~ Rev. Anthony Urban
