#### Pastor's Corner

Greetings to all of you in the name of Christ! Now that it's November, with the leaves on the ground and the colder temps, many of us are now looking toward \_\_\_\_ (the "C" word \_\_\_ pastors don't like rushing there before Advent, you know - wink). And some are thinking of the new year ahead. I would like to encourage you all to do that in a particular way. To that end, I'd like to share an illustration that didn't make it into my sermon series on stewardship ...

About 50 years ago (in the mid 1970's), there were four men who used to meet together each week in Memphis. One man was a service station owner, one man was a salesman for a wholesale appliance company, one man was assistant treasurer of a large corporation, and one man was a teacher. These men shared with each other their longings, desires, and plans. They decided to set goals and to share these with each other. The service station owner set a goal to be making \$50,000 a year within five years. The

wholesale appliance salesman set a goal to be making \$25,000 a year within the next five years. The teacher set a goal to be teaching in one of the greatest educational institutions in America within five years. The assistant treasurer said he was going to do the best he could, but he was not going to set a specific goal.

Within five years the service station owner was making in excess of \$50,000 a year. In the year 2,000 he was worth over one million dollars. Within four years the wholesale appliance salesman was making \$25,000 a year. By retirement, he was a very wealthy man. In two years and ten months the teacher was offered the best teaching job in his field in the United States. But as for the asst. treasurer, 15 years after their meeting, he was still working at his same job in the circumstances that he was in the day the goals were set. *Aim determines direction*. When you aim a pistol toward a target, how you aim determines the direction the bullet will go. The conscious and sub-conscious goals you have for your life have brought about the situation in which you find yourself today. A goal you set, an aim you determine with your intellect and emotions is one of the most powerful forces in the world. And when you do it for the true *Owner of everything*, it's even more powerful! Regardless of your age and situation, I'm challenging you to "aim" your time, abilities, and spiritual gifts to the kingdom vision we've been given: "To be the heart, voice and hands of God, making a lasting difference in others' lives, the community and world." Don't just "do good where you are," AIM, so that God is served well, and lives are transformed by his presence. Amen. Reverend Brian Kilbert



A Devotional for you — Read Psalm 24:1-2 (three times) & Matthew 25:15-19

By the time you read this, we will have finished up a 6-week series on stewardship, but almost none of the messages were about money specifically. So, a quick reference to that here is timely, but it's also good to summarize the big picture. First of all...what is stewardship? Stewardship is simply the wise management of God's resources. It's as much about living as it is about giving. It reaches into every part of our

lives. When we joined the Church, we promised God that we would be faithful members of this part of Christ's body – Puckety Presbyterian - and uphold it by our prayers, our presence, our gifts, and our service....

And the better we are at being good stewards by our prayers, our presence, our gifts and our service ... the more possible it is for us to be able to reach the world with what is our **primary stewardship -- the most valued treasure of all -- something we possess through the gift of faith-- the life-changing gospel of Jesus Christ** to those people who have not yet received it. *Stewardship--in a nutshell--is what a person does after he or she says, "I believe."* 

We're almost to Thanksgiving. Thanksgiving is about gratitude. And true gratitude responds in joy at what has been received in the act of sharing and giving to others. Rick Warren says that giving benefits our lives in multiple ways:

"Giving makes me more like God ... Giving draws me closer to God... Giving breaks the grip of materialism... Giving strengthens my faith... Giving is an investment in Kingdom purposes on earth and eternal realities in heaven ... Giving makes me happy!" (*The Purpose Driven Life*)

Thanksgiving, please hear me; thanksgiving isn't merely a good time for annual traditions and counting blessings we've received. It's a time to consider WHAT WE DO with those blessings. It is the perfect occasion to aim our hearts resolutely to making our gratitude a life-directing attitude – making thanksgiving into (you guessed it) thanks-living. How are you going to channel your gratitude through the "light-staffed" ministries at Puckety or via your spiritual gifts in the community? It is our responsibility to yield to the Owner ... to let Him guide us ... to let Him direct us. I'm NOT talking about taking the initiative out of God's hand – but I am talking about trusting God more.

We all must go beyond the call to merely 'believe' in Christ (the word for 'believe' in the New Testament isn't in reference to a mental action but an action of the *will* – like the word 'love') ...we must demonstrate that faith by our dedication, preparation and service. Happy Thanks-living. Amen.
