DESCRIPTION: Famed bow hunter Jack Howard was also a bowyer who made a limited line of bows, primarily the Gamemaster, Jet and Supreme Target. His bows were considered high-end bows and highly sought after. The Gamemaster kept the same design for decades and there is no way to accurately date the bow. Some of his last Gamemasters sold for as much as \$1,000. The riser appears to be of Brazilian Rosewood and Phenolic with maple lamination strips. White face limbs and black back limbs. Limbs are in very good condition. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in good condition. No drilled holes: No stress lines or crazing. There is some unevenness and minor scrapes along the center laminate. Also some minor discoloration. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in very good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Then taken to the range and test shot. Comes with a new rug rest and side plate, and a new string.
