Dear residents, unit owners or investors tenants old and new, who are new to the community. Please be sure to register with the office. Call to schedule a time to come in and review the rules and regulations with us. If you are a new owner, bring your deed and if you are new tenant, bring your signed lease.

There is still an ongoing problem with people Who move into the community don't register with the office. You will not be considered part of this community if you do not or have done the following:

- Come to the office and introduce yourself with a copy of your signed lease or new deed to the unit.
- Complete a Registration form (from the office).
- Once you have done that, we issue you a parking permit and pool pass.
- The office is opened from 9-5 Monday through Friday.

Please respect our maintenance team and only call after hours for Maintenance Emergencies

Emergencies maintenance handle are-

- A leak that can't wait until the next business day
- Clogged toilet in a one bathroom condominium only
- Fire Alarm- after calling 911
