George Washington has lived; visit Arlington National Cemetery and the grave of President John F. Kennedy, which is marked by the Eternal Flame, and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier where you will view the Changing of the Guard; Lincoln Memorial situated in West Potomac Park; the Jefferson Memorial; the Roosevelt Memorial; the Vietnam Memorial; the World War II Memorial and the Washington Monument. We ride down Embassy Row and see the Washington Cathedral...the Smithsonian Museums, the National Air and Space Museum, the Museums of American and Natural History. We will see the Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts and the famous Watergate Buildings. George Washington's Mount Vernon is not only America's most popular historic home—it is also the country's oldest historic preservation project. As you walk through the Mansion adorned with original heirlooms, you will explore history first hand and get to know the "real" George Washington. On the March/April departure, you should be able to enjoy the beauty of the Japanese Cherry Trees. The annual springtime festival commemorates the 1912 gift of 3,000 Japanese cherry trees from Tokyo Mayor Yukio Ozaki, who gave the trees to Washington in an effort to enhance the growing friendship between the United States and Japan. You will see hundreds of cherry trees which line the Tidal Basin . . .nature's floral tribute to the season! Summer tour spends July 4th in Washington for all the special holiday activities as fireworks light up the sky. Regardless of when you visit our nation's capital, you will agree that it is always beautiful and there is much to see and do. Dinner included one evening in DC. **D**
