S/M Burke was a FRA Life Member of 53 years. Charles passed peacefully in his sleep at Sunnyside Village Health Care Center in Sarasota, Florida, at the age of 92. Charles was a WWII and Korean Conflict veteran and survivor of the Normandy Invasion. He reached the rank of Senior Chief Hospital Corpsman and was USNMC retired. He was a

member of the VFW and the Fleet Reserve Association. Charles was a long time member of the Shriners and served as Commodore of The Mariners.
