

# OTTO GODY ELSESSER

## 1929 - 1993

Otto Gody Elssesser, 64 of Unionville, died Saturday, July 24, at the Ann Arbor Veterans Administration Medical Center, following a short illness.

Mr. Elssesser was born May 24, 1929 in Sebawang, son of the late Bill and Cristina (Gabriel) Elssesser.

He married Betty Rabideau July 4, 1970 in Rapid City. She survives him. He was employed by the Michigan Milk Producers Association, retiring in 1986 after 34 years of service. Having served four years in Korea, Mr. Elssesser was a life-time member of Sebawang VFW Post #4115, a past member of the American Legion, and a member of Teamsters Local #486.
