

## Camping Ethics and Regulations

### **General Camping Regulations:**

- Check in for camping is on a first come, first serve basis and opens at **5:00pm** on the Thursday night before the Fair starts.
- All campers must be registered with a camping pass visibly posted in camping unit
- Only registered campers are allowed on grounds past 11:00 pm
- Gates are closed at 11:00pm. All visitors must leave at this time.
- Excessive noise is not permitted. Please be respectful of others and respect the decisions made by security and Fall Fair Board representatives.
- Liquor consumption is prohibited everywhere on the grounds with the exception of your campsite.
- When camp is broken there should be absolutely no garbage left anywhere. Use the garbage cans and recycling bins provided throughout the grounds or take it home.
- Quiet hours in the camping area are between 11:00pm -6:00am.
- Ensure that **no equipment** or **generators** are operating between 11:00pm and 6:00am.
- Only **ONE vehicle** may be parked in camping area with your unit. **All other vehicles** must be parked in the general public parking area.
- There are no power, water or sewer amenities available in the campground
- There is a full bathroom and pay showers available on the main grounds.
- Bicycles are not permitted on the grounds at any time.
- Smoking is permitted only in designated smoking area which is located behind the church close to the camping area gate. Use provided pails and sand, making sure it is extinguished before leaving area.

### **Campfires**

- **NO CAMPFIRES** or **OPEN FLAMES** ARE PERMITTED ON THE FAIR GROUNDS AT ANY TIME
- THIS BAN INCLUDES ANY OPEN FLAME, ARTIFICIAL PROPANE SIMULATED FIRES ETC.
- ONLY CLOSED BARBECUE UNITS/ CAMP STOVES ARE PERMITTED TO BE USED
- If you are unsure please check with the main office or talk to the security BEFORE using, Thank you.

### **Pets**

- Pets are permitted.
- Pets must be on a leash or in a kennel/carrier at all times.
- You are responsible for their behaviour and wellbeing.
- Dispose of their excrement properly with a bag.

### **Vehicles, Livestock and Roadways**

- Parking is permitted only in designated areas, following the directions of the parking attendants.
- ATV, UTV, and golf carts are only permitted for registered volunteer staff and special permits for disabled visitors may be approved by registering at the office for a permit.
- Horses and riders are not permitted past the cattle barns or in campsite at any time.
- If vehicles are parked in a roadway or undesignated area, the vehicle will be towed away at the owners expense.
- Safety and emergency access are number one.

- The area is patrolled by security and Fall Fair volunteers. Please respect and follow their directions.
- You are responsible for your own personal belongings.
