Our tithing recipient for May is the Center for Law and Military Policy (CLMP). Founded in 2017 by Christian Scientist and JAG officer Dwight Stirling, CLMP is a non-profit organization dedicated to improving the lives of our nation's service members and veterans by strengthening their legal rights and helping to fix the deep-seated problems that lead to homelessness, mental health issues and suicide. Recently CLMP launched the Brothers in Arms Initiative, whose mission is to close the civil-military gap. With only 1% of the American population serving in uniform, the disconnect between military personnel and society getting larger. The goal is to bring attention to the lack of connection between service members and the civilian community and then to identify concrete ways to end the isolation, so that reintegration into society will be significantly easier when they leave the military.
