

GREYWOLF SERVICES GEAR LIST

Weapon:

Safe functioning weapon- If your weapon is determined to be unsafe by the staff, you will not be allowed to use it during the course. We currently have no extra weapons available to rent or lend. *Please ensure that your weapon is fully operational and safe*.

Ammunition:

You must provide a minimum of 200 rounds (preferably 300) of ammunition for CCW 2 and 3. You may bring extra ammunition if you desire to practice (time permitting of course). **BALL AMMUNITION ONLY!** We will be firing at steel targets. <u>No</u> re-loads allowed.

The HR 218 course requires 30 rounds of ammunition for each weapon. We must receive your weapons information prior to the qualification date.

Magazines:

Extra magazines for each caliber of weapon used (bring at least <u>three</u> per weapon). The courses are designed around the semi-automatic weapon. If you will be firing a revolver, please bring additional speed loaders.

Safety Equipment:

Eye and ear protection is available if you do not have your own.

Please bring your own baseball (billed) cap.

Appropriate dress:

The range is located outdoors so please dress accordingly. A shelter is available if bad weather occurs. **NO** shorts due to possible fragmentation from shooting the steel targets.

Wear clothing which covers your weapon. Dress as you would while carrying concealed. You will be drawing your weapon from a concealed location.

Meals:

We provide a sandwich lunch for the CCW and Basic Firearms Course. An outdoor BBQ area is available for those who wish to bring and prepare your own meals.
