



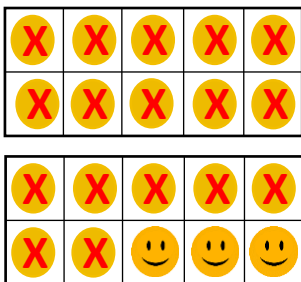

Chapel

In honoring God first at the start of the week, at Sonlight Bay we begin with Chapel on Mondays, or the first day back after holidays. Appropriately titled P-W-S-D 10:27, our students sing songs of praise and worship to Him and then seek to discover more about Him, their relationship with Him, and their relationship as His servants within the world. They are personally engaged in the experience as they learn to seek and develop a biblical worldview perspective. Throughout the exploration, they are challenged to question, think, test, discuss, and make connections as they express their thoughts and/or feelings through various mediums. In doing so, they take ownership in developing their individual personal relationships with Him. The closer they draw to Him, the closer He draws to them (James 4:8). With 8.5 out of every 10 teens turning away from God as they go off to college, as our students grow older and move into that season, such a relationship will be difficult to abandon (Ron Luce, Teen Mania International). Placing Him in His rightfully designated position of first, serves as a reminder to us to keep Him at the center of it all as we progress throughout the remainder of the week and follow the path we ask Him to bless and direct for us.
