Butcher cows were steady to a little stronger Tuesday and both Holstein steers and colored steers sold very well compared to previous weeks. The bull calf market was slightly lower, but the heifer calf market was very weak. We've been getting more and more heifer calves in the last several weeks and there just doesn't seem to be much demand. There are a lot of pretty nice calves, both heifers and bulls, that sell for \$50 to \$75 and that just doesn't add up to much. The Springer sale on Thursday was considerably cheaper, but was better than I thought it might be. We didn't have a big run of cattle and I thought the good heifers sold well considering the state of the Dairy industry. Things are definitely tough out there and we've all go the mid-winter blues, but lets try to remain positive and look forward to better days ahead. Have a great week and we'll see you at TLA!
