#### **DONATE FOR SUMMER MEALS FOR FAMILIES IN NEED**

Dear Friends,

The annual "Ruth W. Shapiro March for the Hungry" project will take place this year during June and July. This project is part of NCJW SE Atlantic section's continued commitment toward improving the lives of women, children and families in our community. March for the Hungry will provide nutritious non-perishable food to programs such as WECARE at the Soref JCC and LifeNet4Families to help families during the summer vacation when their children are not receiving free and reduced cost meals in school.

There are over 450,000 people in Broward and Palm Beach counties who are food insecure and do not know from where they will be getting their next meal. Over 155,300 children in Broward and Palm Beach counties go to bed hungry!

Your generosity will help provide food to families in need. Each \$36 donation will provide approximately 11 meals to someone in need; \$50 will provide about 15 meals and \$100 will provide almost 32 meals. Those who donate \$250 and above will have their logo placed on our website and will receive a certificate of appreciation.

We challenge you to help us reach our goal of providing 1,000 meals over the summer. Together we can make a significant difference in our community!

#### **KIDS AND GUNS**

A panel discussion- *Guns and Kids: Preventing Tragedies* was held on May 13, at the Hagen Ranch Road Library. The panel consisted of Tom Gabor, author and criminologist, Dave Kerner, County Commissioner, Capt. Mike Wallace of the Palm Beach Sheriff's Office, and Dr. Debra Robinson of the Palm Beach County School Board.

The turnout was excellent and audience was alert and engaged. We learned that in Florida a child is shot every 17 hours, and that more children die here from guns than from illness. We were also informed that while handguns are banned in the United Kingdom and that only about 100 people own handguns in Canada, in Florida 1,800,000 people have guns.

In addition to shocking facts and statistics, panel members suggested that if a child is invited to a friend's home, the parent should ask if there are guns in the home and how they are stored. A gun not stored safely is a tempting toy for a child.
