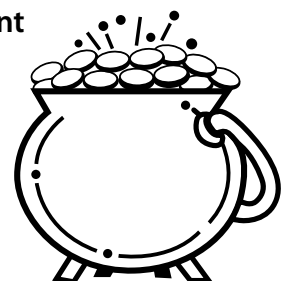
MADAM PRESIDENT

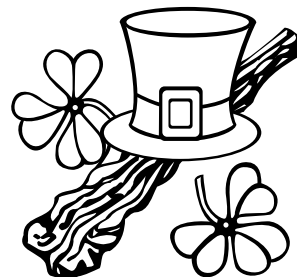


Greetings

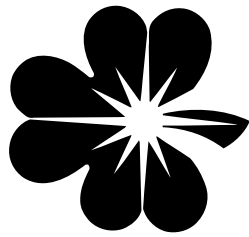

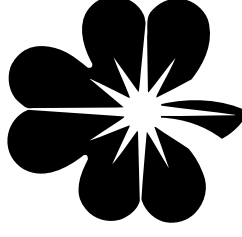
