What I love about CKC Tracking

I started tracking with my first Labrador Retriever, Kurri, in 1987. Since then, I have tracked with 5 other Labradors, including my latest, a 6-mo-old puppy, Myles, who is yet to trial. I have participated in several dog sports including Obedience, Rally, Agility, Working Certificate, Hunt Tests, Scent Detection and skijoring, but Tracking is my very favourite dog sport.

Initially, I was attracted to tracking by the 'wow' factor. It seemed like such an amazing thing for dogs to do. My dogs loved it and I found their energy and excitement contagious. That primal energy traveled up the tracking line to me. I loved the quiet of fields early in the morning when I was laying track and running my dogs. This was the days before urban, though. Urban sites aren't quite so peaceful or beautiful, but they have more variety and challenges compared with field sites. I still find tracking to be relaxing and therapeutic, at least most of the time.

Tracking gives me a window into the world of scent. My dogs are my guides to a secret world I barely know, with scent swirling around and pooling in various unexpected places.

After my first TD pass, I realized I had to learn to read my dog well enough to know what is he was thinking at every moment along the track. Learning to read my dogs has created a very close bond with my tracking dogs, closer than in any other dog sport. To run a blind track or a test successfully, I needed to let go of the illusion of being in charge and accept that my dog was the senior partner on our team. I am support staff. I must cede control to my dog and trust that he is sufficiently competent to navigate the challenges that are presented with the track we are running. Running blind tracks can be unsettling but oddly comforting. My dog has my back, so to speak, and only he can get us to that coveted final article.

As I gained experience with tracking tests, I came to enjoy trialing my dogs. Every judge and every site creates a track with unique challenges. Tracking people are generally more laid back and less intense than the other dog sport communities I have encountered. CKC tracking is non-competitive. Everyone wants you to pass, if for no other reason than to get you and your dog moved on to the next level and out of their way. As well, most of my tracking training doesn't require anyone else, so I don't have to work with with any negative or bossy people. I am free to solve problems by myself without anyone telling me what I should do.

Tracking has given me a deep respect for my dogs. Tracking is the only sport where I am not telling my dog what he should do. When I lay a challenging track, I can watch my dog figure out how to solve the puzzle I have set for him. My greatest pleasure is watching my dogs confront any challenges on their tracks and confidently work through them using their experience and intelligence. I truly believe my dogs feel a real sense of accomplishment when they are successful.

Peanut Butter and Pumpkin Dog Treats

- 2 cups flour

Directions

- 1. Preheat your oven to 375°F.
- 2. In a large bowl, mix together the pumpkin and peanut butter.
- 3. Stir in the flour and combine the mixture into a dough.
- Roll out the dough onto a floured surface.
 Cut the dough into shapes with <u>your favorite cookie cutter</u>.
- 1. Place the treats 1/2 an inch apart on an ungreased cookie sheet.
- 2. Bake for 12 minutes.
