Good evening trustees, my name is \_\_\_\_\_.

I am submitting into the public record facts relative to wireless radiation and the health of the students and teachers. Internet links for the assertions presented here are being provided for submission into the meeting minutes.

You have been informed of the lawsuit against the Fay School in MA for failing to accommodate a 12-year-old student's alleged Wi-Fi sensitivity. Electro Hypersensitivity (EHS) is also known as Electrosensitivity or Microwave Sickness. That court case will go to trial in August.

Erica Mallory-Blythe is a medical doctor who became Electrosensitive and wrote a paper in which she states that EHS is a cumulative, exposure-triggered condition characterized by increasing trigger susceptibility and irreversibility. Once you become EHS, it is irreversible. To recover from its effects you must avoid further exposure.

The Austrian Medical Association released a consensus paper with guidelines for the diagnosis and treatment of EHS. Two additional sources are a French study by Dr. Belpomme and the European Academy for Environmental Medicine, which provides comprehensive guidelines on the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of EHS.

Tragically, an EHS teen, Jenny Fry 15, was found hanged to escape her health related reactions to the Wi-Fi at her school.

Peter Sullivan has worked in high-tech and was an Executive Officer and pilot in the United States Navy. He created a short video in which he discusses the most likely environmental factor contributing to the suicide cluster at Gunn High School, relating it to the EMF exposure. Gunn High School is in Silicon Valley, CA.

Jeromy Johnson holds a master's degree in engineering and had a successful career in Silicon Valley before he began to experience negative health effects from wireless technology. "Many EHS people have had to give up their career, home, school, community and family in order to find a safe place to exist in our modern world that is now filled with EMF pollution. There have been many suicides around the world related to severe cases of EHS. Thus, the condition can have devastating effects on individuals and families." Jeromy recently spoke at the TED TALK Berkeley; the title of his talk is "Wireless Wake-Up Call".

Our children have hopes, dreams and aspirations for the future. I'm certain the teachers do, as well. The pursuit of this future will all be severely challenged, if not impossible, by mandatory exposure to microwave radiation in the \_\_\_\_\_ high schools.

This is not to be ignored or dismissed. There is no amount of E-Rate funding that will compensate for manifestation of this health hazard on the lives and futures of our children.
