START TIME	FILM	SYNOPSIS
10:00 am	Free Rein 52:00 min	Free Reins is the emotional story of a 63 year-old maverick, Patty McGill, and her "tribe" – a diverse group of kids, families and volunteers who participate in an unconventional brand of equine assisted therapy at Hinchinbrook Farm.
11:00 am	Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart: Requiem 70:00 min	An absolute highlight of Salzburg's Mozart Week with "highest art of sound and riding": the French equine artist and theatrical genius Bartabas presents Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's Requiem. Horses and riders from the formidable Academie Equestre de Versailles join forces with the Musiciens du Louvre, conducted by Marc Minkowski, the Salzburger Bachchor and "an excellent quartet of soloists".
12:15 pm	AMISH 2.0 53:00 min	A farmer from the Netherlands dreams about moving to the United States with his family. His goal is to live closer to his most satisfied clients: the Amish. This documentary provides a rare peek into the world of the - usually so isolated - Amish Community. Sober and simple, would define the Amish lifestyle, but the temptations are becoming rather great for them.
1:15 pm	Leg Up 72:00 min	This documentary film tells the story of a lifelong horseman's journey back into the saddle. The struggles, both physical and emotional, he has endured and his passion and determination to return to his life with Arabian horses. Ernst is an inspiration to all, especially the horse community who understand how almost unfathomable his return to riding is. The bond between horse and human is a powerful and healing energy and this is a journey that must be shared.
2:30 pm	The Great Florida Cattle Drive 57:00 min	The mission of the Great Florida Cattle Drive: Unbroken Circles is to share Florida's unique cow culture and heritage through living history. The goal for Live Oak Production Group was to capture a week of showcasing the lifestyle of the working Florida cowhunters moving cattle across private and public lands from St. Cloud (just south of Orlando) to Kenansville in January 2016. This story is much more than a week of educating people about historical accounts. One important element of the project is to educate the public about the 500 years of cattle and horses in Florida.
3:30 pm	Branding, Roping and Stock Handling Techniques 90:00 min	A beautifully photographed, detailed instructional film that teaches the roping and stock handling techniques of the Great Basin Buckaroo and old California Vaquero. Filmed on some of the west's most sprawling and iconic "big outfits," the film takes viewers to the "land of the buckaroo" and affords them an authentic experience in this masterfully assembled production.
5:00 pm	BASK: The Revelation of America 43:00 min	This documentary film "Bask. The revelation of America", presents the unique and fascinating story of the Arabian horse Bask. It's a beautiful but also tragic story, a remarkable tale of a horse that has survived the very worst due to its proximity and remarkable relationship with man. Bask struggled to achieve success in America by crossing the Atlantic Ocean and surviving a storm and many horrors along the way. In America, he was called the "revelation of America".
6:00 pm	Riding With thisABILITIES 56:00 min	Disabled children participating in a therapeutic horse program in NYC benefit during program and over time. After their graduation the stable is sold and the program ends. Other programs fill the void left but the need outweighs the availability. As a society we need to spend more money on programs like therapeutic riding so that everyone has a chance to "Ride with theirABILITY."
7:00 pm	Into The Spotlight Part 2 63:00 min	Into the Spotlight Part 2 feature length documentary also shines the spotlight on horse rescue and unwanted horses in the United States and the unimaginable risk of horses whose lives take the fateful turn that places them on the road to slaughter.

Together they won the heart of millions all over the world, winning three titles at the FEI World Equestrian Games and setting multiple record scores in Kentucky in 2010
9:35 pm	The Adventure Of Selika 07:00 min	When Selika flees the comfort and safety of her home in rural France, she sets out for Paris to forge her own independent path in the world. "The Adventures of Selika" is based on an image of Selika Lazevski, about whom little is known. The image was by Felix Nadar, renowned 19th century French photographer of celebrated people (authors, scientists, painters . . .). Curious and puzzling, I was struck by the strength and pride that exude from this image of a beautiful black woman elegantly dressed in a riding habit, believed to be an equestrian of haut dressage in 19th century France
9:45 pm	JAR – Journey Of A Horseman 51:00 min	Follow the entertainers incredible life from Motown recording artist to his 5 star rated charity working with at risk youth using horses in his programs.
