It's also that time of the year when the rankings on Lax Power start to give us an idea about where teams are. There are a lot of games, important games left to play, but we can get a sense of who the top team might be. So lets look at the top ten, as of now, and see what their schedules have to tell us.

#1 Carmel (InReg 99.43)

#2 Hamilton Southeastern (InReg 98.01) Quality Wins: none Games Vs. Top 10 teams left: Guerin, Zionsville, Cathedral, Brebuef, Culver and Culver

#3 Cathedral (InReg 97.72) Quality Wins: St. Joseph's 16-5 and Brebeuf 9-4 Games Vs. Top 10 teams left: Culver, Guerin, Hamilton Southeastern, Zionsville and Carmel

#4 Culver Military Academy (InReg 95.01) Quality Wins: Zionsville 12-6 and St. Joseph's 11-4 Games Vs. Top 10 teams left: Cathedral, Carmel, Hamilton Southeastern and Brebeuf

#5 Guerin Catholic (InReg 91.23) Quality Wins: Westfield 10-4 Games Vs. Top 10 teams left: Hamilton Southeastern, Brebeuf, Cathedral and Carmel

#6 Westfield (InReg 89.68) Quality Wins: Zionsville 11-10 Games Vs. Top 10 teams left: Bishop Chatard, Carmel, Brebeuf and Hamilton Southeastern **#7 Zionsville** (In Reg 89.56) Quality Wins: Guerin 6-3 and Brebeuf 11-10 Games Vs. Top 10 teams left: Hamilton Southeastern, St. Joseph's and Cathedral

#8 Brebeuf Jesuit (InReg 89.14)Quality Wins: NoneGames Vs. Top 10 teams left: Carmel, Guerin, Westfield,Hamilton Southeastern, St. Joseph's and Culver

#9 St. Joseph's (InReg 88.73) Quality Wins: None Games Vs. Top 10 teams left: Zionsville, Brebeuf and Carmel

#10 Bishop Chatard (InReg 87.03) Quality Wins: None Games Vs. Top 10 teams left: Westfield

Looking at this list a few things jump out at me. The top 3 teams are all separated by less than 2 points. Anyone of them could be #1 and they all have a lot of big games left to play. Culver is less than 2 points from the top 3, they seem solid as the #4 right now. Which means that the top 4 teams are only separated by about 4+ goals. Then there's a solid break from the rest of the field when you consider that Guerin, #5 is then another 4 points or so back of Culver. But #5 Guerin to #10 Bishop Chatard is only about 4 points again. That means in that group, the games should be really close. And frankly, anyone of them could win on any given day. That's fun.
