

JUDGEMENT

There are three different judgments mentioned in the New Testament. Consequently, there is some confusion concerning the nature of God's judgements upon men. Those who hold to an amillennial eschatology believe that all three judgements are one in the same event. On the other hand, Pre-millennialist believe that these three judgements are completely separate events, done for specific purpose and at specific times.

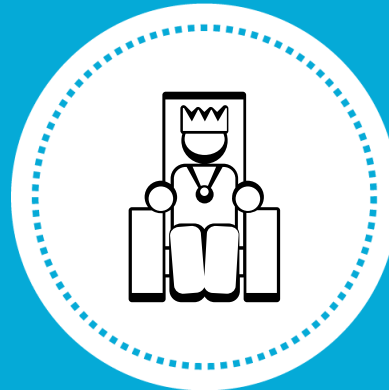


**Glorious
Throne**

Matthew 25: 31- 46

Jesus returns to judge the nations. This event occurs after the end of the tribulation and before the millennial kingdom begins.

This judgement is for the survivors of the tribulation period. It is also known as the sheep and goats judgement.

Revelation 20: 11-15

Jesus renders final judgement upon individuals. This happens after the end of time and before eternity.

This judgement is only for those who do not know Jesus Christ. They will all be thrown into the Lake of Fire for eternity.

2 Corinthians 5: 10

This happens after the end of time and before eternity.

This is the judgement of believers only. They will all go on to live with God in the new heaven eternally.
